



Required Insurance Documentation

Scholastic Ensembles are not required to provide proof of insurance.

Independent Ensemble Insurance Requirements: \$1,000,000 General Liability coverage and proof of **Accident Medical** coverage (suggested limit of \$5,000 but can be less) policies are required per organization.

- Proof of insurance certificates must include the CWEA recognized group name.

WGI has arranged a favorable group rate through Francis L. Dean & Associates of Colorado, LLC for a \$450 minimum premium for the General Liability & Accident Medical package. [CLICK HERE TO BUY INSURANCE ONLINE](#) All policies are annual (12 month) policies and cannot be negotiated for less than the minimum premium amount. IMPORTANT: The certificate of insurance must list CWEA (POST OFFICE BOX 3614, ROCK HILL, SC 29732) as additionally insured. It will not be accepted without this information.

The General Liability policy protects your group, instructors, directors and officers against claims of bodily injury liability, property damage liability, and the litigation costs to defend against such claims. This coverage should also allow a group to rent rehearsal facilities, as most require proof of coverage.

The Accident Medical Payments covers all participants, volunteer workers and staff members while participating in sponsored and supervised activities and while traveling, directly and without interruption, to and from sponsored and supervised activities and their homes or places of residence.

All independent groups must provide proof coverage to the CWEA office. Failure to do so may void your entry into any CWEA event.
