Turn right

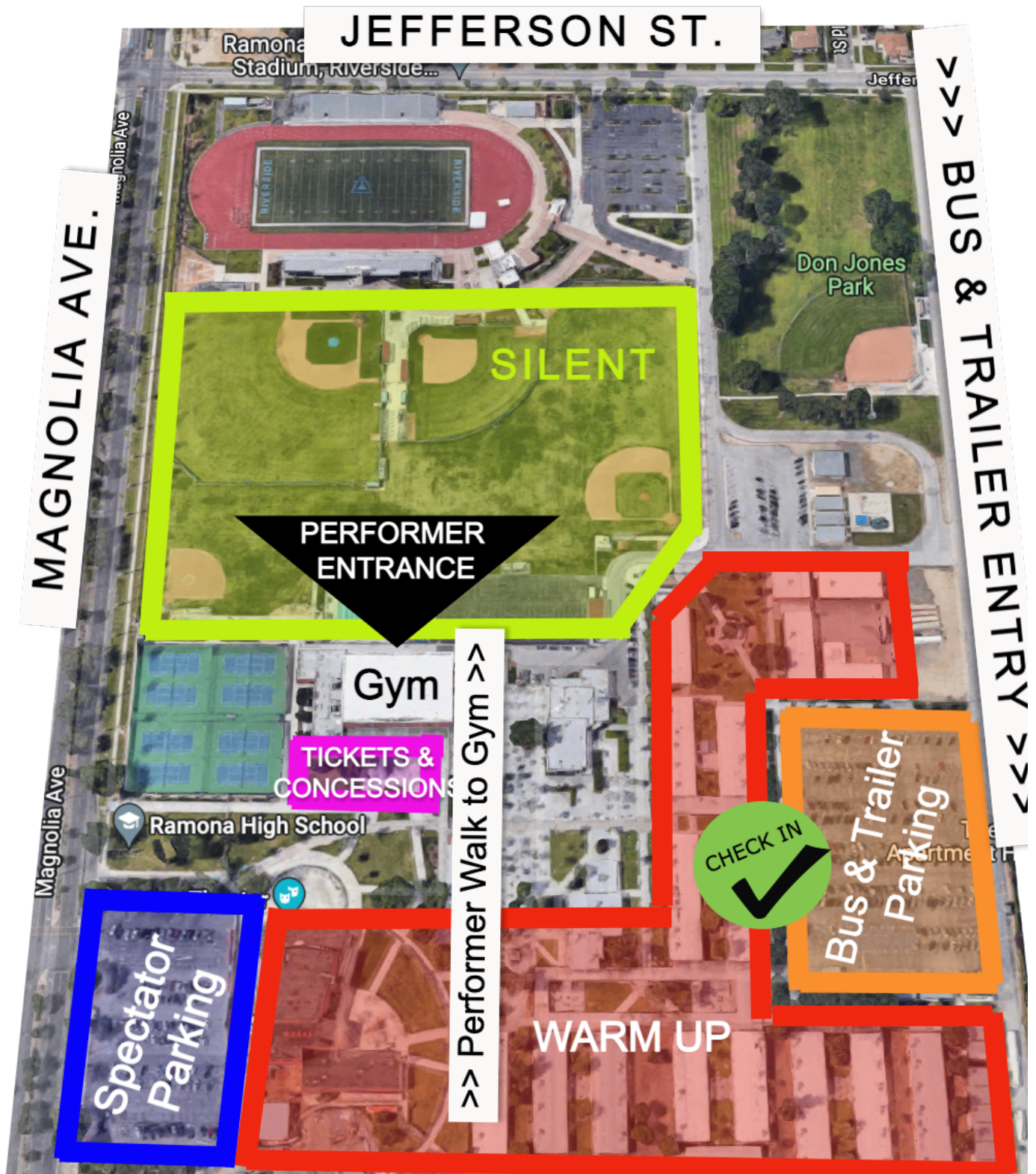
Buses and Trailers

PERFORMER WALK TO GYM

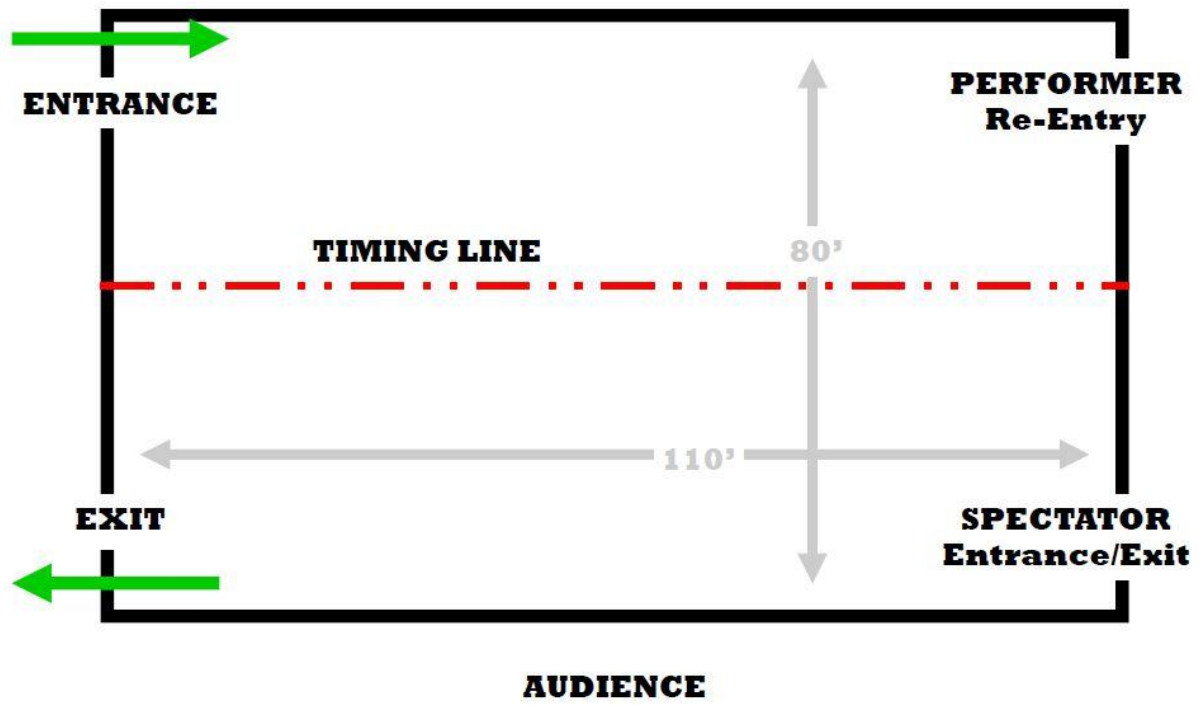

Director Information

Wristbands & Staff Badges

Each performing group will receive:

- Student Wristbands: required for performance, provides access to back bleachers after performance
- Chaperone Wristbands: 1 for every 8 performers, required for performance, provides access to the back bleachers after performance
- Director and staff badges and lanyards: required for entry and hospitality

Please note: If we reach capacity limits we will ask performer spectators to exit the gym to make room for paid spectators.

Warm-Up

Warm up spaces are not assigned because there is plenty of space.

Out of professional courtesy, please aim metronomes and full ensemble sounds away from each other.

Percussion Equipment and Props

You may leave the props in the “prop staging” area, (see map on previous page) as long as they are against the walls and not blocking roads. Please keep your storage zone neat and accessible so other units may effectively use the space, as well.
