Spectator Parking and Admission

Paid Parking (\$10 per vehicle) for spectators will be in the **Fourth St. Parking Lot** adjacent to the stadium. This lot is equipped with solar panels.

General Admission will be \$15. Children 5 and under will be granted admission free of charge. Please keep in mind that seating for our tournament is on a first come first serve basis. The gates to the stadium for admission will open an hour before the first performing group.

First Aid

Please make sure your band is aware of the location of our **First Aid Station**. It will be located next to the Information Booth, near the Ticket Booth, as you enter the stadium on the spectator side.

Arrival/Wristbands

Wristbands for Directors, Staff, Performers, Pit Crew/Parent Helpers will be available in your Check-In Packet upon arrival. Wristbands will allow entrance to the away side of the stadium only. Any chaperones that wish to watch on the home side will be asked to purchase a **General Admission Wristband** from the Ticket Booth - \$15.

Bus/Equipment Truck Parking

Transportation Team will meet the visiting Bands at Check-In on Fourth St. and Vine - located on the southwest end of campus (see map). They will guide you and your band to your designated parking area. Vine St. will be open through the Chaffey High School Campus for Bus/Support Vehicle Parking. All vehicles will enter from the southwest and exit through the north creating a One Way Route. Please try to have trucks & busses arrive together. Space is limited and we appreciate your flexibility!

Music Warm-Up Areas

Warm up areas can be found on the main campus (see map). Please make sure to play away from the stadium out of courtesy to the other performing groups. Please be aware of 'Quiet Zone' locations and try to stay off the grass as much as possible!

Percussion Equipment/Props

Please make sure you have adequate staff and means to assist the moving of your percussion equipment and props to and from the performance area. Please see the detailed schedule for pre-stage times. Motorized vehicles are NOT allowed on the field turf at any time.

Electrical Power

Power will be provided for your equipment on the front sidelines. It will be located on the field near the track by the 50 yard line.

Staging

The staging area is a Quiet Zone. Please inform your musicians that no playing is allowed.

Entering/Exiting the Field and Stadium (Read & See Map!)

Groups will enter the field from the southeast Corner of the Stadium (near Racquet Ball Courts/Cafeteria/Bike Racks). Props may be staged and stored at this same location or next to Gym. Groups will continue to final staging on east end of track. Pit will stage on the home side track. Upon completion of field show, make sure to exit field to the track on Side 2. You will exit with way you entered and make your way back to your parking area. Gatekeepers/Hosts will be there to assist you!

Concession Stands

There will be an assortment of great food, drinks, and snacks for participants and spectators on the Home & Visitor sides. No grills or open fires are allowed on campus, the stadium, or parking lots. This is a fundraising event and we encourage all participants to support our event by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium.

Hospitality

We have a hospitality area (with a field view) for directors and staff members to eat and relax just north of the staging area between the stadium and cafeteria. We invite you to join us for food and refreshments... it's upstairs... follow the signs!
