## Welcome to the 2018 San Clemente High School CSBC Field Show!

Please take time to familiarize yourself with the following information.

### 1. PARKING

- Spectator Parking is available in the side lot (off of Ave Presidio), on the corner of the school (Ave Pico and Presidio).
- Handicapped Parking is available in the bus parking area.
- Bus and Equipment Parking is located in the **main school entrance** off of (Turn right into the lot off of Ave Pico after you exit the freeway).

### 2. GROUP ARRIVAL

Upon your arrival, you will meet your student guides (see section 6 below), and we will provide wristbands for **students (GOLD)**, staff (**RED**) and essential **parent volunteers (YELLOW)**. Please be sure to check your packet upon arrival to see if any changes or updates have been made to the performance schedule. *One chaperone wristband will be given to each band for every 10 students performing.* If you need more wristbands, you can purchase them at the check-in table. All parents/helpers must have a wristband to enter the stadium.

### 3. ADMISSION:

Performers: Free  
General admission: \$10.00  
Seniors: \$7.00  
Children under 6: Free

### 4. CHANGING AREAS / RESTROOMS

Restrooms are available in front of the gym and by the music room, 700. Uniform changing must be done in your buses. PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW YOUR STUDENTS TO USE THE RESTROOM AREAS FOR CHANGING IN OR OUT OF THEIR UNIFORMS.

### 5. WARM UP AREAS

There are 4 areas designated for warm-up. Your designated warm-up area will be clearly marked and your student guides will assist you in locating that area. Your 45-minute warm-up time will begin 55 min prior to your performance or as stated by the CSBC schedule. We're not going to force you to be at the staging gate a full 10 minutes prior to your performance, but anyone responsible for delaying the tournament will receive the maximum timing penalty assessed to your final score. As always, keep an eye on your watch.

**Please do not warm-up in the BUS/TRUCK parking lot. We want to make sure everyone is safe in the parking lot.**

Auxiliary units may use the tennis courts and any portion of the practice field off of Ave Pico. If you use a broadcast metronome (ie: Dr. Beat, hand clapping) it cannot interfere with the performances in the stadium. Plan accordingly.

## 6. GROUP GUIDES

Each group will be assigned 2 SCHS Music Department students who will remain with your group.

They will answer any questions you might have on the day of the performance as well as help to keep a line of communication open between you and the show director. It is your responsibility, as always, to keep an eye on your times.

## 7. FOOD – please read this

We do **not** allow preparation of food on the SCHS Campus. This is per school district policy and will be enforced at tournament time by show host staff and head judge. Do not set up tables/easy ups as all parking spots will be needed.

Terrific food will again be available at very reasonable costs. We will offer a variety of food, drinks, and snacks that are sure to satisfy even the hungriest person's needs!!!

We are proud to host the 2018 Field Tournament and work hard to bring a consistently successful competition for the students and their parents.

*However, the sale of food and beverages is the single largest source of income for our entire event.*

Please support our Instrumental Music Support Team as they support our performers in all of their endeavors.

## 8. JUDGING

Judges are supplied by the CSBC.

## 9. ANNOUNCER

All announcements will be done from the press box.

## 10. FIRST AID

Due to our district policy, we are to call 911 instead of providing first aid. For minor first aid needs, see music volunteer inside snack bar. There will be radios and cellular phones on site for emergencies.

## 11. PIT CARTS / ASSISTANCE (Steps for Success)

- Drop any large field props in designated area adjacent to snack bar upon arrival or with plenty of time before you go on.
- Start moving to field entrance 20 min. before performance.
- Move to **STAGING AREA** inside fence area on track 10 min. before performance.
- When the previous band's performance is finished, proceed forward and unload equipment.
- **You will exit through the same gate you entered.**
- Motorized vehicles are NOT allowed on the track per the CUSD Stadium use policy.
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## **12. ELECTRICAL POWER**

Electrical power is available at the field level on the front of the field near the 50 yard line.

**If we blow a fuse, it is the competitor's responsibility to have a back-up source of electrical power.**

## **13. PERFORMER RE-ENTRY AND SEATING**

Performers may re-enter the stadium after their performance and sit in the visitor's stands. Room permitting, they may sit on the far ends of the home-side stands. This will be determined the day of the event.

## **14. PERUSAL PERIOD**

The 5-minute perusal period will take place during the awards ceremony. At this time, you may check for mathematical errors on the score sheets and recaps. You may then approach the head judge to speak with an adjudicator as inclined.

## **15. DIRECTOR'S HOSPITALITY TENT (RED bracelets only please)**

The Director's Hospitality Tent will be located behind the MAIN GYM just before entering the stadium. Please visit and enjoy!

## **16. RAIN**

Rain is officially not allowed at our show. In the event of unauthorized rain we will move the competition into our large gym (which actually doesn't sound too bad). **YOUR BAND WILL BE JUDGED RAIN OR SHINE.** Staging will be in the MAIN gym (attached). We will judge captions as space allows. No refunds will be given as the food is purchased; a basic judge's fee is charged for reporting to the show, and the incurrence of other start-up expenses.

We wish you best of skill to you and your group at the 2018 San Clemente High School's CSBC Field Show. I am looking forward to seeing your performance on Saturday Nov 3, 2018.
