Thank you for attending this year's Oak Hills Field Tournament at Oak Hills High School. We are excited to host your group and look forward to a great day of marching band! ARRIVAL/CHECK IN/ BUS PARKING

Bus parking will be in the north parking lot off of El Centro Road

ADMISSION:

Tickets will be available at the ticket booth accessed through the parking lot stadium. General admission is \$10.00, children, seniors, and military are \$7.00, and children 5 and under free

WRISTBANDS:

Wristbands will be provided for the number of performers listed on the information you provided CSBC. Also, we will provide you with a total of 1 chaperone wristbands per every 10 students as well as wristbands for your staff members based on registration information. Wristbands will be handed out at the check-in near the entrance of the bus parking lot.

CONCESSION STAND:

A variety of food and beverages will be on sale for students, chaperones, and spectators. This is a fundraiser event so please encourage all participants to support the Oak Hills High School Band program by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium. Please see the menu for items and costs. Per district rules there is no cooking or barbecuing allowed in the Oak Hills parking lot.

PERCUSSION EQUIPMENT:

Please be at the stadium 15 minutes prior to your performance time so that we can pre-stage the equipment. No gas powered vehicles are allowed on the track. Make sure to have adequate staff or pit parents to assist moving your percussion equipment to and from the performance area. The performance area is not close to the warm-up area so allow yourself plenty of time to get there. If you should need help with equipment let me know and I can provide some kids to help.

AWARDS CEREMONY:

Leaders should be sent to the track following the last band's performance. They should meet on the track nearest to the stadium restrooms.

WARM-UP AREAS

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up, and percussion warm-up can take place on campus or on the green grass area off the Coyote Trail parking lot. The silent area will be anything south of the gym, please do not allow percussion or band to warm up in the silent area and make sure to have instruments and long rangers facing away from the stadium. Colorguard is free to warm up anywhere on campus including around the gym, there will be some nice shade under the solar panels as well. Allow yourself plenty of time to walk from the warm-up area to the performance gate. The head judge will not wait for you to arrive and when it is your turn to perform an announcement will be made to take the field. Please be prepared to enter the field at least 15 minutes before the performance time.

STUDENT SEATING IN THE STANDS

After your performance students may sit in the home side stands or away side stands. If you choose to have your students sit in the home side please make sure that they sit in the stands outside of the 30 yard line and that they are supervised and do not disturb any of our spectators.

PROPS

If you have props and would like to leave them near the gate before your performance then please feel free to bring them by the "band and pit entrance gate" on the south east side of the stadium. There is plenty of room there to store props until your performance time. If you need to make alternative arrangements for props please contact us and we'll do our best to accommodate you.

CHANGING AREAS

There are no changing areas provided. All changing should take place in your busses, outside, or in bathrooms on campus. No locker rooms will be available.

HOSPITALITY

There will be a hospitality area available. The hospitality tent will be on the north side of the away stands by the away snack bar. Please see the map for directions. Also, advise your group that this is a private area for band directors and staff members.

RESTROOMS

There will be two sets of restrooms available, one in the stadium and one near the D building on campus.

FIRST AID

There will be a first aid area available on the north side of the stadium area on the track near the restrooms.

PROGRAMS

Tournament programs will be available near the ticket booth and throughout the stadium.

ADJUDICATION

We will be utilizing CSBC judging for our tournament.
