#### **DIRECTIONS**

## From the SOUTH:

- -Travel NORTH on I-15
- -Exit at "El Norte Parkway"
- -Turn RIGHT and travel EAST on El Norte Parkway.
- -Turn LEFT and travel NORTH on Broadway: "LOOK FOR THE SIGNS"
- -BUSES and STAFF Travel to the THIRD driveway on the LEFT for your parking lot entrance.
- -SPECTATORS continue NORTH to the NEXT driveway on the LEFT for your entrance.
- -You will be directed to your parking zone

## From the WEST:

- -Travel EAST on CA-78
- EXIT at CENTER CITY PKWY NORTH
- -Turn RIGHT and travel EAST on El Norte Parkway.
- -Turn LEFT and travel NORTH on Broadway: "LOOK FOR THE SIGNS"
- -BUSES and STAFF Travel to the THIRD driveway on the LEFT for your parking lot entrance.
- -SPECTATORS continue NORTH to the NEXT driveway on the LEFT for your entrance.
- -You will be directed to your parking zone


#### From the NORTH:

- -Travel SOUTH on I-15
- -Exit at "El Norte Parkway"
- -Turn LEFT and travel EAST on El Norte Parkway.
- -Turn LEFT and travel NORTH on Broadway: "LOOK FOR THE SIGNS"
- -BUSES and STAFF Travel to the THIRD driveway on the LEFT for your parking lot entrance.
- -SPECTATORS continue NORTH to the NEXT driveway on the LEFT for your entrance.
- -You will be directed to your parking zone

## **CHECK-IN:**

The CHECK-IN tent is located just outside the main stadium ticket gate. It is labeled "A" on the diagram on page 5.

CSBC has allotted a "1 for every 10" policy for chaperone/parent wristbands. Additional tickets can be purchased at the ticket window if needed.

## Bus, Truck, Staff Parking Entrance

Warm-up areas have been designated for each group. The entire campus is available for battery, front ensembles, and guard.

Make sure to bring a generator or battery for power.

Please make sure any metronomes and full ensembles are aimed away from the stadium so as to not interfere with performances or show logistics.

All units will enter and exit on SIDE 2. Enter through the breezeway and exit through the main gate. Units "on deck" will pre-set on the track outside the south zone.

Front ensembles need to arrive by your gate time.

Props can be staged before-hand in the SIDE 2 area shown on the map.

Please ensure you have adequate staff and assistance to move your percussion and props to and from the performance area. NO trucks or vehicles of significant weight will be allowed on the track

Wristbands must be worn at all times to enter/exit the stadium.


Wristband quantities are controlled by CSBC, not by EHS. Tickets must be purchased for parents/chaperones beyond the allotted number.

Leaders will be assigned a yard line or split to parade to, and will proceed to that point (on the front sideline) when introduced by the announcer.

The awards ceremony will begin approximately 30 minutes after the last performing group finishes. A meet & greet with the CSBC Judges will be held near the Hospitality Room.
