1. PARKING

Spectator parking is available in the parking lot located off of 16th street adjacent to the main entrance to the stadium. Additional parking is available on the street outside of the stadium and in the surrounding neighborhood.

Band bus and trailer parking is located in the 15th street lot on the South side of the school. Staff will be on hand to provide direction. Look for the signs indicating Bus Parking. Check-In will be at the entrance to the parking lot.

Handicapped parking is available in designated spots in the lots listed above.

2. ENSEMBLE ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

CHECK-IN is located at the side of the bus parking in the 15th-Street parking lot (look for the EZ-Up Tent). Please plan to arrive with plenty of time to park, unload, and prepare for your performance. Upon arrival, you will meet your student guides, and we will provide wristbands for students, staff, chaperones and essential parent volunteers. Please be sure to check your packet upon arrival to see if any changes or updates have been made to the performance schedule.



3. WRISTBANDS FOR PERFORMERS, STAFF, AND CHAPERONES

All students will receive a wristband that should be worn at all times during the event.

Chaperones / **Staff**- Each school will receive 1 free chaperone entry wristband per every 8 students.

Director Credentials- At Semi Finals, each Director will be issued 1 VIP ALL ACCESS badge and CSBC Lanyard. If an Assistant Director has been registered with the CSBC, 1 VIP ALL ACCESS badge and CSBC Lanyard will be issued to the ensemble for the Assistant Director. These are to be used for Directors/Assistant Directors ONLY. These badges will be their credentials for both Semi Finals and Championships. Directors should retain these badges for both weekends.

Any non-uniformed/non performing persons must display a wristband or Director's badge in order to enter the performance area; no one will be allowed to enter the stadium/performance area without providing proper credentials. This includes anyone who is assisting in bringing equipment or props onto the field.

Bus Drivers- CSBC will issue bus drivers a free wristband for entry into the show provided that they fill out and return a bus driver entry application. The bus driver entry application will include the bus driver's name, and phone number so that the host site can get in touch with them should they need to contact them.

One chaperone wristband will be given to each band for every 8 students performing.

After each group completes its performance all parents must have a wristband or pay admission to re-enter the stadium.

If additional wristbands are needed you will be able to PURCHASE them at Check-In and the stadium box office for \$20.00. No one will be admitted into the stadium stands without a wristband.

4. ADMISSION

5. RESTROOMS/CHANGING AREAS

Restrooms are located in the building behind Check-In, Lunch Quad Area, South end of Stadium. Uniform changing may ONLY be done in your buses. *Please DO NOT allow your students to use the restrooms for changing in or out of their uniforms.*

6. FOOD – please read this

We do not allow preparation of food on any Newport-Mesa Unified School campus per school district policy; this will be enforced on competition day.

A selection of delicious, fresh, warm entrees will be available a la carte. Beverages such as water, a large variety of sodas, coffee, tea and hot chocolate are available at the Concessions stand along with candy of all kinds, fresh popped corn, nachos and chips.

We are proud to host the 2021 CSBC Championships, and work hard to bring a consistently successful competition for the students and their parents. However, the sale of food and beverages is the single largest source of income for our entire event.

Please support our NH Music Education Foundation as they support our performers in all of their endeavors.

7. WARM-UP AREAS

There are designated fields for warm-up. Your designated warm-up area will be clearly marked and your student guides will assist you in locating that area. Please do NOT use the bus parking for warm-up. Your warm-up time & location will be noted on the CSBC Logistics Schedule.

Anyone responsible for delaying the tournament will receive the maximum timing penalty assessed to your final score.



Auxiliary units may use any portion of the athletic fields for their warm-up. If you use a broadcast metronome (i.e.: Dr. Beat) it cannot interfere with the performances in the stadium. Plan accordingly.

8. GROUP ESCORTS

Each band will be assigned Newport Harbor High School student ambassadors who will remain with your ensemble until after your performance. They will answer any questions you might have on the day of the performance as well as help to keep a line of communication open between you and our staff.

It is your responsibility to keep your eye on the time.

9. FIRST AID

Due to our district policy, we are to call 911 instead of providing first aid. For minor emergencies or health problems, there will be a First Aid station next to the restrooms at the stadium entry gate.

10. SECURITY

All NHHS parent volunteers/band boosters are easily identifiable in navy blue NHHS t-shirts and for Area Leads and Security staff, a NHHS neon safety vest. Any issues or concerns should be directed to any of our adult volunteers. Everyone's safety is our top priority.

11. PIT CARTS/ASSISTANCE IN THE STADIUM

- -Drop large props in designated area adjacent to the score board, near the West end of Stadium upon arrival
- -Move to field entrance (south-west end of the field) 20 min. before performance
- -Move to the waiting area inside fence area on track (south-west end of the field) 10 min. before performance
- -When the previous band's performance is finished, proceed forward and unload equipment
- -After unloading, pull forward beyond the goalposts, turn around, and wait for the end of your show
- -You will exit through the same gate as the band, in the North-EAST corner of the stadium
- -Motorized vehicles are NOT allowed on the turf field per the NMUSD Stadium use policy
- -Neumatic/air-filled wheels ONLY allowed on the track and turf field



12. ELECTRICAL POWER

Electrical power is available at the field level on the front of the field near the 50 yard line. If we blow a fuse, it is the competitor's responsibility to have a backup source of electrical power.

13. PERFORMER RE-ENTRY AND SEATING

Performers may re-enter the stadium after their performance through the VISITOR GATE which is the same gate where the bands will exit, and sit in the visitor's stands. Room permitting, they may sit on the far ends of the front sidelines. This will be determined the day of the event.

14. DIRECTOR'S HOSPITALITY

The Director's Hospitality will be located at the East end of the stadium in the classroom next to the restrooms and concessions. We have found this to be a good place to visit with friends, take in some great nourishment and keep an eye on the students and the tournament. Please visit and enjoy!


NEWPORT-MESA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DAVIDSON FIELD STADIUM USE RULES

The field is a synthetic surface (Field Turf) and the track is an Atlas synthetic surface. Both of these products require the following rules to assure the stadium

remains in a safe and operational condition.

- NO PETS
- NO PAINTING ON FIELD OR TRACK SURFACE
- NO ANCHORING DEVICES (STAKES) USED ON FIELD OR TRACK SURFACE
- NO SUNFLOWER SEEDS OR GUM
- NO FOOD, SPORTS DRINKS OR FRUIT (WATER ONLY)
- NO GLASS BOTTLES OR CONTAINERS
- NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS, FIREWORKS, OR OPEN FLAME
- NO BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS, IN-LINE SKATES OR VEHICLES (INCLUDING SCISSOR LIFTS)
- NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 ALLOWED ON SIDELINES UNLESS
 DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN THE EVENT
- DO NOT USE ANY TAPE OR ADHESIVE MATERIAL ON FIELD OR TRACK
- PNEUMATIC/AIR FILLED WHEELS ONLY ALLOWED ON TRACK AND TURF
 FIELD

You must restrict your sidelines (for coaches, players, and support personnel only) and make sure all individuals on the sidelines follow the above guidelines at all times.
