WELCOME TO THE 2017 CIRCLE CITY CLASSIC FIELD TOURNAMENT!

Directors,

Thank you for choosing to attend our 11th annual field tournament, part of the California State Band Championships series. We will welcome 30 bands to the show this year. To accommodate the larger show, we have secured some additional parking areas. We look forward to providing a great experience for you and your students.

ARRIVAL & BUS/TRUCK PARKING

I have attached maps for your convenience. The easiest way to get to our campus is from the 15 fwy. From the south, exit at Ontario, turn left, and then turn right (north) onto Rimpau. From the north, east, and south, transition to the 15 fwy. Southbound, then take the first exit at Magnolia. Turn right onto Magnolia and make the quick left onto Rimpau. All buses and trucks should enter at the school traffic signal.

SPECTATOR PARKING

Spectator parking will be located in our faculty parking lot, on the southeast corner of the campus. Any spectators with a visible handicapped placard or handicapped license plate may enter the student lot (where busses and trucks will be parked), and will be parked closer to the stadium as space allows. We will have overflow parking available at Stallings Elementary School, located on Fullerton Ave. There will be a spectator entrance on that side of the stadium.

ADMISSION PRICES

General admission - \$10. Children and seniors - \$7 Family Special: 2 adults & up to 3 children - \$30
We will also have a full-color program for sale for just \$2. All spectators will be hand-stamped.

PERFORMER HAND STAMPS

Our Check-In team will meet your busses upon arrival. All students on your buses will receive a hand-stamp valid for re-re-entry to the stadium.

STAFF WRISTBANDS

You will receive wristbands for your staff that will permit them to enter the stadium & field and also visit our hospitality area. Staff wristbands will be assigned as follows:

1A – 3 wristbands 2A – 4 3A – 5 4A – 6 5A – 7 6A – 8

PARENT HELPER WRISTBANDS

You will also receive wristbands for your parent helpers/pit crew that will permit them to enter the stadium & field. People with these wristbands are not required to purchase admission. Anyone with a wristband and/or handstamp may help move equipment on and off the field. Wristbands will assigned as follows:

1A – 5 wristbands 2A – 6 3A – 8 4A – 10 5A – 12 6A – 14

STUDENT GUIDES

Student guides will be assigned to each band. These students can assist you with finding your way around campus, finding restrooms, and staying on schedule. They can also answer questions or assist with communication to the event coordinator or head judge.

WARM-UP AREAS

We have several areas for warm-up, including our upper practice field, which is lined. We have rented portable lighting for the field area, and areas inside campus will have adequate lighting. Several sets of restrooms will be available for your convenience.

FIELD ENTRY/EXIT & PRE-STAGE

All units will enter (band, pit, & guard) from the side 2/right front corner and exit out the side 1/left back corner. (See map for details.) When a band enters the field, they will be pre-staged behind the east end zone, with their pit/props staged on the track. The entrance to the stadium features a short hill, but it is paved and 15' wide.

VEHICLES AND PROPS

Only electric powered golf carts will be allowed onto the track. Please also be sure that all props and podiums have wheels or are carried in such a way as to not damage the track. NO gas-powered vehicles are allowed onto the track or field.

POWER

We will provide power and a short cord at the 50 yard line on both sidelines. You must provide your own extension cord.

JUDGING/SCORING

This competition is part of the California State Band Championships circuit, and comments and scores will be provided by CSBC staff. Please visit www.calstatebandchamps.org for complete contest rules and more information.

PERFORMER RE-ENTRY

Performers in divisions 1A, 2A, & 3A will be seated on the home side of the stadium. Performers in divisions 4A, 5A, & 6A will be seated as space allows. Student performers may only seat in designated areas.

FIRST AID

Our First Aid station will be located just inside the stadium gate.

SNACK BAR/VENDORS

A variety of vendors will be available, including the legendary Centennial Band Boosters snack bar!

HOSPITALITY

All staff wearing a staff wristband will be admitted to our awesome hospitality area. Please, NO parents or bus drivers in the hospitality area

FOOD PREPARATION

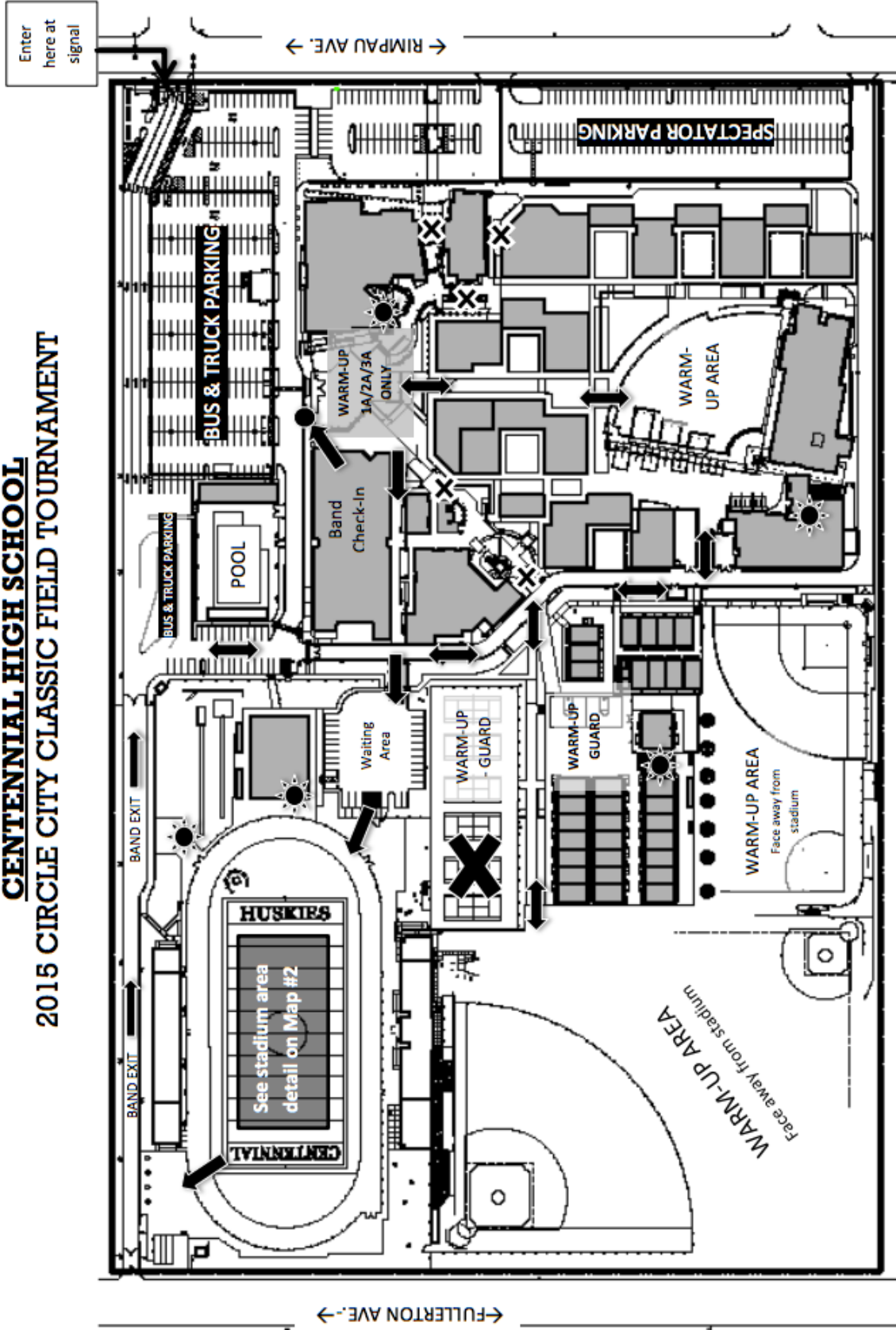
You may bring snacks or pre-packaged food for your students, but on-site food prep is not allowed. No cooking of any kind will be allowed. If you set up tables and canopies, we may ask you to move them to accommodate parking.

BUS & TRUCK EXIT

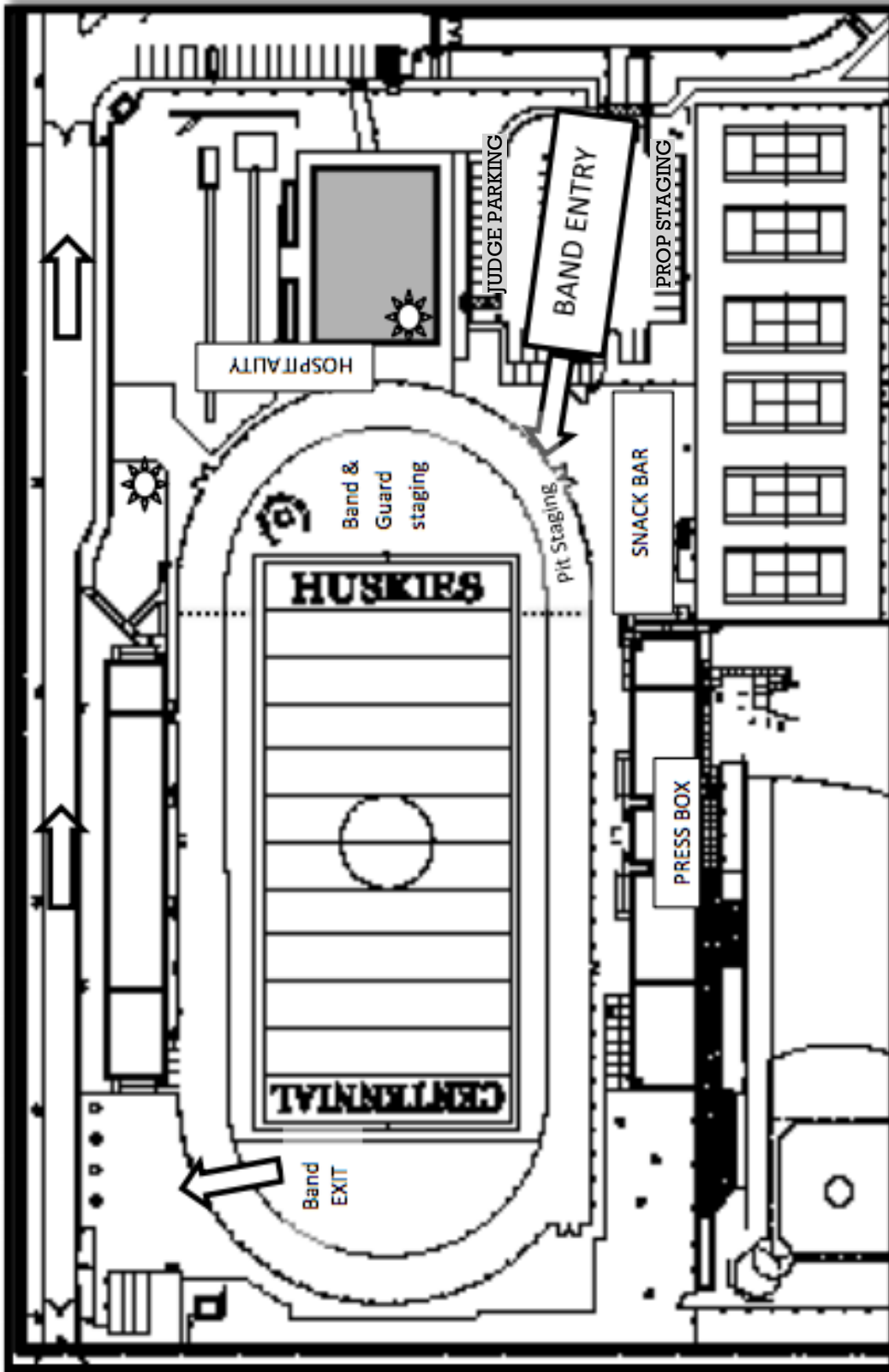
At the end of the day, we will direct ½ the vehicles out onto Rimpau Ave. The other ½ of the vehicles will exit behind the stadium onto Fullerton Rd. From Fullerton, a right turn will take you to Magnolia and another right will get you back to the freeway. If you came from the west (mostly 5A bands), you will want to get on the 15 to the 91 or go all the way across 6th street to Lincoln to get on the freeway. I do not recommend using the Main St. or Grand on-ramps due to all of the construction.
