## 1. LOCATION

## **2. PARKING**

You will likely be heading South on Main Street to HBHS. The campus will be on your right. Please note that buses, trucks, and cars will be directed to different parking areas.

- Bus Parking will be primarily in the school's parking lot. The entrance is off of Main, 1 traffic light South of Yorktown. (They could also enter at Utica via Northbound Main Street, again at the light.)

We have newly installed solar panels now, so we may measure the buses heights as needed to insure their safety. Most buses will be fine with clearance. Some schools will be directed to park on Main Street, or on 17<sup>th</sup> Street.

Buses will be parked tightly in the back lot, in what I call "Hollywood Bowl" style. Buses may not be able to leave until the division awards are done.

PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOU WILL BE LEAVING EARLIER THAN AFTER YOUR AWARDS.

No cars or SUV's allowed in this lot

- Truck Parking will once again be on the field behind our gym. This is only accessed by turning right off of southbound Main Street, south of Yorktown. The driveway is between the stadium and the auditorium. Trucks will then drive down a driveway to the back of campus, and be parked in the field. (Note: if they miss this entrance, turn left at the light at Utica, left on Lake Street, left at the light at Yorktown, and left at the light at Main Street and try again...).

- Spectator/Car Parking will be in one of several areas off site. This will be at either the Civic Center across Main Street from the stadium, or the business park caddy-corner from the stadium, or on the neighborhood streets. Cross streets are Main Street and Yorktown. Please see the attached map.

DO NOT park at Seacliff Shopping Center. AND please alert your parents that the portion of the Civic Center lot nearest the stadium is police station parking only - *vehicles will be cited here!* This lot is marked red on the enclosed map.

Feel free to distribute the enclosed auto parking flier.

- Handicapped Parking is available near the stadium. Cars will enter off of Main Street at the Truck entrance. Spaces are limited.

### **3. GROUP ARRIVAL**

Please do not arrive more than two hours prior to performance time. Parking is simply too tight. Please!

Upon arrival, please go to the Band Check-in, located in the bus parking lot. Here you will meet your student guides, and receive your director's packet. Please check to see if there are any changes in warm-up areas, etc.

### **4. ADMISSIONS**

You already received your director's pass/lanyard (and an assistant's if they were listed) last Saturday. Please wear it at this event. Wristbands for performers (be prepared to give us an accurate number – CSBC will confirm) and, per CSBC, 1 wristband per every 8 performers to be used by ensembles for staff, volunteers, or however you see fit, will be given out at check-in. Additional admissions may be purchased at the regular admission price at the main gate, or at the check in table (cash only). **Performer wristbands may NOT be used by adults for admission.**

Please note: **Everyone entering the stadium at any point must have a staff pass or wristband. This includes all pit/prop movers!** Thank you for your cooperation on this matter!!

Admission price is

\$20.00 for adults;

\$15.00 for seniors and students with ID

5 and under are free

Programs will be \$5.00.

## **5. FOOD and CONCESSIONS**

Terrific concessions will be available again this year at very reasonable costs. (See enclosed menu). We are proud to host the 2021 CSBC Championships, and our parents and students work hard to make this event run as smoothly as possible for all performers and audience members. Please support our booster group that is hosting this event by choosing to eat with us on Saturday!

There is no room available in the parking lot for tailgate set-ups. If you are setting up tables, tents, camping chairs, etc., - please do so in one of the nearby park areas, not in the parking lot. It will be roomier, and a lot safer!

And, of course, there are no fires or BBQ's of any kind allowed per district policy. And don't get upset with us if we have to remind you of this...

No ice chests nor any outside food will be permitted in the stadium.

## **6. CHANGING AREAS/RESTROOMS**

Restrooms are available at the campus student center as well as in the stadium. Uniform changing must be done on your buses.

## **7. WARM-UP AREAS**

Campus maps will be given to you at check-in. Warm-up areas will be assigned to assure every band an ample warm-up period. Our hosts will lead you to your warm-up area. Plan on no lined fields, and lighting may be marginal in some areas after dark. Electricity will not be available.

Please also recognize that our campus is located in a neighborhood. While we have tried to move the warm-up areas away from as many houses as possible, *I respectfully ask you to try to keep loud sounds to a minimum.* This particularly applies to drum lines, loud metronomes, or both, playing for hours on end... The HB Police will ask offending groups to stop. We are concerned with issues early morning and late night especially. Noise ordinance prevents any music warm-ups prior to 7:00am.

These are warm-up areas, not rehearsal sights. Please do that at your own school prior to coming to this performance sight.

There is a field adjacent at Worthy Park (past the bus parking) which can be used for color guard and marching warm-ups.

We ask that you not disturb the performances, and CSBC may issue penalties. As a general rule, if you can see the stadium, they can probably hear you. There is also a concrete stretch thru the middle of our campus that projects sound amazingly well directly into the stadium. Avoid any playing in the posted "quiet zones."

Please keep the parking lot and truck parking area free from playing.

Props may be pre staged on the field next to the stadium at the Band Entrance.

## **8. STADIUM ENTRANCE / EXIT**

Bands will be directed to the staging area. Gate times are listed on the schedule. Guides will not be responsible for getting your band there on time. All non-performers must have a staff pass or appropriate wristband to enter here. No exceptions!

Bands will be entering from the rear of side two (stage left). The CSBC announcer will let you know when to enter the field.

Bands will exit through the same gate. Bands entering the performance field will have right of way, please.

## **9. FRONT ENSEMBLES/PITS**

The pit entrance into the stadium is also the band entrance. Upon entering the stadium, pits proceed around the track to the left as mentioned above. Please keep movement/noise to a minimum during performances.

There will be power at the 50 yard line (front side only). **Bands are responsible for their own back-up in the event of lost power.**

Having the fake turf field, and the rubberized track, our district is understandably concerned about anything happening to these surfaces. Believe it or not, our district developed an 18-page document regarding stadium usage (!). We have proven year after year that marching bands do not ruin the facilities, but we still need to protect our facilities. We do not anticipate any problems.

**Gas powered vehicles are NOT ALLOWED on the track at any time.**

Those bands bringing gas powered pit vehicles/trailers will be able to drive these to the pre-stage area near the end-zone, where you will need to unload your equipment as above.

## **10. AFTER YOUR PERFORMANCE**

We ask that adults returning to the stadium please use the main entrance gate (off Main Street). Staff with lanyards may use the Band entry tunnel, which is near the hospitality tent. Students may enter at either the main entrance, or off the driveway behind the visitor's stands.

Concessions are located at the main entrance, as are restrooms. Additional restrooms will be available near the back stands as well.

*Please encourage your students to plan to eat with us. We have a wide variety of foods planned. (It's an easy way to say "thanks" to the show hosts at any competition!)*

## **11. STUDENT SEATING**

Students returning to watch other bands will primarily be seated in the back-side stands. During the day show, we may be assigning some bands seating on the home side bleachers on the far sides. These areas will be marked.

**12. FIRST AID**

First aid will be located in the stadium for minor medical issues. 911 will be called if necessary.

**13. DIRECTOR/STAFF HOSPITALITY**

Directors and staff are invited to visit our hospitality area located under the stadium scoreboard for food and drink (not *that* kind...). **Parents and students** will not be allowed in this area.

**14. AWARDS CEREMONY**

Student leaders only for the 4A, 5A, and 6A class awards. Leaders should meet at the band entrance after the final band in 6A performs.

**15. RAIN PLAN**

In the unlikely event of rain, adjudicated performances may be held in the gymnasium. Dry warm-up areas will be very limited.

**16. THOSE BANDS NOT PERFORMING AT THE EVENING FINALS**

It is assumed that Bands not qualifying for the evening's championships will be leaving after the 4:30 awards ceremony. If this is not the case, please let us know when you check in. Your busses and trucks may be moved to a different location to allow others to leave.

I believe that's all! Thanks for participating in the CSBC! We hope you find it an enjoyable and educational day!

## **California State Band Championships** **4A/5A/6A State Finals**

### **FOR THOSE BANDS MAKING THE EVENING FINALS**

Congratulations! Please check your performance time carefully. These are determined by CSBC. All bands will be competing against each other regardless of division!

Everything from the morning show is pretty much duplicated.

All passes/wristbands from the day Division Finals are good.

Warm-up areas and times have been assigned.

All non-performers entering with the band or pit must have a staff pass or an adult wristband (chaperone or purchased).

After the performance, students will be seated in the back field stands only.

### **AWARDS CEREMONY**

After the final band's performance, **all performers will meet in full uniform for a full retreat.** Bands should report to the field behind the gym (warm-up D area, by truck parking). Please have drum majors in front. Bands will be placed in performance order. They will all be led into the stadium for the full retreat.

# CSBC @ HBHS

## auto parking information

Due to the size of this tournament, and the number of participants, the school lots must be used for school busses and trucks only. Cars, SUVs, etc. will not be allowed in the school lot.

Car parking is suggested as follows:

### Civic Center parking at Main and Yorktown

This is across the street from the stadium's main entrance, but some distance from the band's busses. This is most convenient for spectators. DO NOT PARK in spots with restrictions (closest to Police Station and Main Street) - you will get ticketed! Pedestrians cross Main St. at the corner.

### Business Park at Main/Yorktown caddycorner from stadium

This is across from the Civic Center and Seacliff. Easy in and out. Close to spectator entrance.


### Street Parking

There is lots of parking available on the streets in the neighborhood adjacent to the school, particularly to the East. Expect 5 minutes of walking, but an easy exit.

### Albertson's/Seacliff Shopping Center at Main and Yorktown

DO NOT PARK HERE! This lot is across from the stadium, but they may tow your vehicle. Please avoid this lot.  
(Despite the fact that hundreds of students purchase meals here each week, they are unfriendly towards school event parking!)
