



Hello Directors,

Thank you for joining us and bringing your bands to our 5th Annual Driller Marching Showcase on October 11<sup>th</sup>! Below you will find the information you need for our competition. Please pay close attention to how parking will work for the event. It has changed, Primarily for spectators.

## Box Office

The box office will be open starting at 2:00 for our first performance beginning at 3:00. There will be tickets sold at the north and south entrance to the stadium, tickets are \$8 per person, and programs are sold for \$2

## Wrist Bands

In your check-in packet, you will be provided with wrist bands for your students, and an additional set of wrist bands for your chaperones and instructors. CSBC guidelines are for there to be 1 additional band per 10 students.

Any student or parent who is going to enter will need a wristband. This includes all pit crew. Pit crews will have seating available at field level during their groups performance. Following the performance, pit crew wristbands will be good for admission through the main gate, so they can do any necessary chaperone duties.

## Lanyards

CSBC has mailed Lanyards ahead to the directors, if you have not received those please contact [info@calstatebandchamps.org](mailto:info@calstatebandchamps.org). These will grant you and staff access to the hospitality area. This is under the home bleachers, entrance is from in front of the bleachers at the Side 1, 35 yard line.

## Check In

There will be a check in table as you come down campus way (see map). Your badges and wristbands will be given to you at check-in. This is also where your vehicles and equipment will be led to their parking areas.

## Bus and Equipment Parking

School buses will be parked separate from the equipment vehicles. We park them in the student unload zones on campus, and one parking lot. Equipment vehicles will be parked on the streets through campus, surrounding the warm up areas. **Your parking area reservation is based on the number of vehicles you have specified in your competition suite**

## Spectator Parking - **New Information!!!**

The East end parking lots will be used for spectator parking. Administration no longer allows parking on the field behind the stadium. This will make some of the equipment a bit tighter, but we've spent a lot of time planning safe exits for everyone.

## Warm Up

There are a few warm up areas available. Please make sure to warm up East of F St. Any of those grass areas are available. Remember to point away from the stadium as a courtesy to the performing ensembles.

## Pit Equipment

In the schedule, it is advised that the percussion ensemble arrives before the band. All performers will enter from the Southeast side of the stadium (Back Side 2), and Exit the Northeast side of the stadium (Back Side 1). There is a curb with a ramp at the exit side. If you need alternate exit options, we can accommodate.

## First Aid

We will have first aid available at the south end of the stadium.

## Band Seating

At the event, there will be a few sections in the front of the stadium for some of the smaller groups that go on earlier in the day. Most of the performers will have seating in the visitors side bleachers.
