Directions

Approaching from the North:

- -Travel South on I-215 or I-15
- -The I-215 and I-15 merge at Temecula's Northernmost exit
- -Travel to the "Temecula Parkway," and Hwy 79 South Exit
- -Exit and travel East on Temecula Parkway
- Turn South (right) onto Pechanga Parkway
- -Turn Left on Deer Hollow Parkway
- -Travel past the first (stadium) parking lot entrance
- -You will be directed into the next (front) lot and led to a parking zone

Approaching from the South:

- -Travel North on I-15
- -Travel to the "Temecula Parkway," and Hwy 79 South Exit
- -Exit and travel East on Temecula Parkway
- Turn South (right) onto Pechanga Parkway
- -Turn Left on Deer Hollow Parkway
- -You will be directed into the next (front) lot and led to a parking zone


Busses will park in the main parking lot in front of the school, adjacent to the 6 warm-ups zones provided for each ensemble

Arrival of your Buses and Trucks

Busses will park in the main parking lot in front of the school, adjacent to the 6 warm-ups zones provided for each ensemble. Please see the image below for more information.

Check-in is located near the spectator lot by the gym. **Look for the "heart"** labeled on the map. Directors arriving separate, we will have designated VIP parking for you nearest the band entry/exit and our hospitality tent.

Wristbands & Staff Badges

Directors will receive this packet upon check-in and receive *wristbands for your students* (required for re-entry into the stadium after their performance). The performer wristbands will give them access to the visitor side stands. Performing groups are welcome and encouraged to watch other bands on the visitor side (see visitor side bleachers pdf for assigned areas).

We are happy to provide chaperone support passes (1 for every 8 performers). If chaperones wish to sit on the home side, they will need to purchase a regular show ticket.

Each of the packets will include Director and staff badges and lanyards

Warm-Up

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up, and percussion warm-ups can be done in the quad areas of our campus. Due to proximity to the stadium and respect to the performing units, do not play music in the parking lots, or areas close to the stadium.

We have designated each of the warm-up zones on campus for each group, and have kept them purposefully distanced from the stadium. <u>Please aim metronomes and full ensemble sounds away from the stadium so as not to interfere with show logistics.</u>

Warm-Up Zones

Warm up areas #1-#6 for Winds and Percussion. Your guard is welcome to use the same zone, as well, or...

Guard Warm up area A-D on the tennis courts. The lights on the tennis courts are activated by pushing the buttons. When the orange/yellow lights begin flashing be sure to hit the button to keep them on. If you are late to hitting the button, the lights will turn off and have about a 10-15 cool down period before turning back on.



Note: electrical boxes on campus are unlocked and accessible for your pits to plug into.

Percussion Equipment/Props

Please make sure you have adequate staff and means to assist the moving of your percussion equipment and props to and from the performance area. Absolutely no trucks or vehicles of significant weight will be allowed on the track.

We ask that all pit percussion sections arrive at least ONE band prior to your groups' scheduled performance time. Front ensembles will enter AND exit at the same entrance on the Southeast entry of the stadium.

Please note there is plenty of space for prop staging. However, *please keep your storage* **zone neat and accessible** so other units may effectively use the space, as well.

Note: locker rooms and restrooms are located in the prop staging and storage zone and near where the units will be lining up for performance.

Band Entry/Exit Point

All performing groups will enter and exit at the Southeast entry gate to the stadium.

The Band that is "on deck," will pre-set on the track outside of the Southeast end zone to leave room for the parting band (see map).

Be sure to have your group positioned to enter the field one full performance slot (13/15 minutes) ahead of your own. Late arrival to the gate will cause a traffic jam of the departing band and may cause a timing penalty. Please plan accordingly.


Spectator Admissions

Unit Seating in the Stands

Upon completion of your band's performance, please make sure they have wristbands to re-enter the stadium. Re-entry is on the opposite side of the spectator bleachers near the Northwest endzone and our concession stand (see previous map). Ensembles have been designated seats on the visitor side to watch the field shows & awards

Please have your leaders line-up in order of performance on the track at the southeast (performer entrance) side of the stadium PRIOR to the last performance.


The awards ceremony will begin after the last performing group (approximately 30 minutes). A meet & greet period will be held near the Southeast end of the stadium (near hospitality).
