Dear Band Directors and Music Boosters:

Thank you for participating in the 24th Annual Scripps Ranch Falcon Marching Invitational. We hope your day will be both successful, educational, and entertaining.

Please review the enclosed materials thoroughly to make your performance the best possible. We want to minimize the number of surprises for you or us on the tournament day. Be advised that the on-site EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER will be (858) 752-7895. This is the cell phone that will be carried the entire day by Mr. Russell Shedd, the Scripps Ranch Band Director.

It is very important that you adhere closely to the warm-up and performance schedule printed later in this packet. Please plan your changing into uniform and individual warm-ups so that you can meet the schedule for official warm-up and performance. There will be an awards ceremony 40 minutes after the final performance. Leadership is asked to be on the south end of the stadium 15 minutes before the start of the awards ceremony.

All student performers will be provided with a wristband when your group arrives. This band is for entrance to the stadium after your performance. Any student without the wristband will not be admitted into the stadium. Directors and all staff members (according to your application) will have name badges. The badges and wristbands will be given to you at check-in when you arrive on campus. Be advised that chaperone wristbands are issued based on the number of performers in your group. One wristband is allotted for every 10 band members. Seating is available on both sides of the fields and in the end zone areas for the last performers. Please do not pressure the gate personnel for additional chaperone wristbands.

It is important that you strictly follow all directions given to you by our parking personnel. We have a lot of groups to accommodate, so your cooperation is critical.

We provide a hospitality room for the convenience of the band director and immediate staff only. It is located in the northeast corner adjacent to the stadium. ONLY those named on the initial application will be admitted.

Finally, please help us to have a green tournament by encouraging your students and volunteers to utilize our recycling bins.

We take pride in putting on a tournament that focuses as much on the educational aspect of the day as on the competitive aspect. If you have any questions, ask any student or parent volunteer, if they can't give you a satisfactory answer they will quickly refer you to someone who can help you work out any problems you might encounter.

CHECK-IN

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Buses are to stop at the top of the hill upon entering the campus. Directors will be given a packet containing identification for all band/guard staff members. Performers and chaperones will also receive a wristband to wear that will identify them. You will be assigned a volunteer, who will guide you and your band around SRHS and help you monitor time.

RESTROOMS & CHANGING FACILITIES

Restrooms are located in the 200, 400, 700 building and the stadium. They will be clearly marked. THERE ARE NO OTHER FACILITIES AVAILABLE FOR CHANGING.

WARM-UP/PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

Please use the map below to locate warm up areas. There are no assigned warm-up areas. If you require power, ensure you have a generator. When warming up, ensure you are facing away from the stadium. Student guides will be on hand to remind and guide you to the next venue so that the entire tournament can stay on time.



HOSPITALITY AREA

The Hospitality Area is located next to the stadium, northeast corner adjacent to the stadium and up the stairs. This area is reserved for directors, staff members (with appropriate badges), and judges. The Hospitality Area will be open at 3:30pm for snacks and drinks. Dinner will be available 5:30-8:30pm.

ADMISSION

General Admission for the tournament will be \$15.00. Students (with valid school ID), military, and seniors will be \$10.00. All children 5 and under will be free. We can accept cash, credit cards, and Venmo. Each spectator will be issued a wristband and not be allowed to enter the viewing area without this wristband. All spectators will be sitting on the Home Side of the stadium.

SEATING

All seating for spectators, and chaperones and performers will be on the Home Side of the stadium. Performers will have a designated seating area in the stands or on the field. Student performers must sit in the designated areas due to an anticipated capacity crowd. Adults who enter with chaperone wristbands are expected to sit with the students. Once groups have finished performing, we invite them to return to the stadium. Larger bands, please sit on the Visitor Side bleachers. If room is available, we will sit everyone on the home side to watch and enjoy band performances.

SPECTATOR PARKING

Please let your parents know that on-campus spectator parking is limited to carpooling vehicles only. Street parking is also available for spectators. Additionally, VIP parking (see map) will be available for purchase for \$20. There is an area reserved for handicapped parking near the stadium. Handicapped placards are required.

CONCESSIONS, SHOUT OUTS AND PROGRAM

A delicious variety of food items will be available for purchase at our concession stands, conveniently located on both the home and visitor site of the field. We will also offer quick snacks and shout outs at an auxiliary table located near the stadium entrance. Purchase using cash, credit cards, or Venmo. Use the appropriate QR code purchase tickets, VIP parking, shout outs, or to view the program.

AWARDS CEREMONY: There will be an awards ceremony 30 minutes after the final performance. Student leaders are to line up on the track at the south end of the field in the order in which they performed. The leaders will be escorted to the back of the field, where they will be announced and brought onto the field with a cadence provided by the SRHS percussion section. Awards will be announced when all leaders are in place.
