ARRIVAL/CHECK IN/ BUS PARKING

Bus parking will be in two parking lots. 1a, 2a, and 3a parking will be off of El Centro Road and 4a bands should park in the lot off of Coyote Trail. All busses and trailers should turn on Cataba Road as there is a light there.

ADMISSION:

Tickets will be available at the ticket booth accessed through the parking lot stadium. General admission is \$10.00, children, seniors, and military are \$7.00, and children 5 and under free

WRISTBANDS:

Wristbands will be provided for all performers as listed on your entry forms. Also, we will provide you with a total of 7 chaperone wristbands and 7 staff member passes (or as many as is stated on registration). Wristbands will be handed out at the check-in on the entrance of the parking lot bus parking.

CONCESSION STAND:

A variety of food and beverages will be on sale for students, chaperones, and spectators. This is a fundraiser event so please encourage all participants to support the Oak Hills High School Band program by purchasing food at the concessions stands in the stadium. Please see the menu for items and costs. There is no cooking or barbecuing allowed in the Oak Hills parking lot.

PERCUSSION EQUIPMENT:

Please be at the stadium 15 minutes prior to your performance time so that we can pre-stage the equipment. No gas powered vehicles are allowed on the track. Please make sure to have adequate staff or pit parents to assist moving your percussion equipment to and from the performance area. The performance area is not close to the parking area so allow yourself plenty of time to get

there.

AWARDS CEREMONY:

Please send your leaders to the pit entry gate following the last band's performance.

WARM-UP AREAS

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up, and percussion warm-up can take place on campus. Please do not allow percussion or band to warm up in the silent area and have instruments and Dr. Beats facing away from the stadium. Make sure you leave yourself plenty of time to walk from the warm-up area to the performance gate. The head judge will not wait for you to arrive and when it is your turn to perform an announcement will be made to take the field. Please be prepared to enter the field at least 15 minutes before the performance time.

GATES

The pit and band entrance and exit will be on the south east side of the stadium. Please arrive at the gates at least 15 minutes before performance time.

PROPS

If you have props and would like to leave them near the gate before your performance then please feel free to bring them by the "band and pit entrance gate" on the south east side of the stadium. There is plenty of room there to store props until your performance time.

CHANGING AREAS

There are no changing areas provided. All changing should take place in your busses, outside, or in bathrooms on campus. No locker rooms will be available.

STUDENT SEATING DURING AWARDS

Students may sit on either the home side or the away side. If they sit on the home side please have them sit on the far ends of the stadium.

HOSPITALITY

There will be a hospitality area available in the Performing Arts Center. Please see the map for directions. Also, advise your group that this is a private area for band directors and staff members.

FIRST AID

There will be a first aid area available on the north side of the stadium area on the track near the restrooms..

PROGRAMS

Tournament programs will be available near the ticket booth and throughout the stadium.

ADJUDICATION

We will be utilizing CSBC judging for our tournament.


