Division 1A, 2A, and 3A will compete in Division Finals at one site, and the three division winners along with the next 7 best scores will continue on to their own State Finals (open class) that evening at the same site. Division 4A, 5A, and 6A will do the same at the Huntington Beach site. By the end of the day we will have crowned six State Division Champs and two overall State Champions!

Please read the instructions below carefully. All of our staff at CSBC, SWMEA and SWJN look forward to hosting all of you for another great State Championship event.

The Schedule:

All schedules are available on www.calstatebandchamps.org

If you qualify for Finals (formerly Grand Championships), please pay attention to the schedule. You are responsible for making sure you are on time (especially if you choose to leave campus to wait it out). We will not hold the show for late bands due to timing restrictions. The two-hour arrival ban is **lifted** for Finals only. Division Champions (1st Place) advance from each division. Then the next seven best scores regardless of division will advance. We won't know who those seven are until Division 3A finals finishes at the Newport Harbor site, and 6A finishes at the Huntington Beach site.

<u>Arrival</u>

Plan your arrival for <u>NO MORE THAN TWO HOURS</u> prior to your performance time. To accommodate all our guests, traffic, and equipment, this policy will be strictly enforced. Please DO NOT give the show host a hard time if they refuse to park you early. This ban is lifted ONLY for Open Class Finals (Evening at both sites).

IF YOU ARE STAYING FOR LATER DIVISIONS, PLEASE HAVE YOUR BUS AND TRUCK DRIVERS AVAILABLE AFTER EACH DIVISION AWARD CEREMONY SHOULD WE NEED TO ADJUST YOUR PARKING POSITION. PARKING WILL BE TIGHT, AND WE MAY HAVE TO MOVE YOU UP OR TO A DIFFERENT ROW. THANK YOU IN ADVANCE FOR YOUR COOPERATION. Please note that bus parking at Newport Harbor High School may be across the street and separated from equipment trucks. Due to solar panel installation, bus and equipment trucks may be separated at Huntington Beach High School as well. Please be flexible!

Parking

Due to the size of the event and large crowd expected, parking will be limited! Specific directions for bus/equipment truck parking must be followed. Parking is limited on campus and must be reserved for school buses and equipment trucks ONLY! DO NOT BBQ or COOK in the parking areas as this is against school district regulations! Please ask spectators and additional staff driving vehicles to allow ample time to park and walk to stadium.

Changing Areas

There are no changing areas. Please do not use the stadium restrooms as changing areas. Please change on your buses.

Warm Up - READ THIS CAREFULLY!

Please report to your assigned warm-up zone. Do not perform music warm-ups outside of your assigned zone.

<u>Staging</u>

All groups must report to staging per the logistics schedule posted on the Newsfeed (homepage) of www.calstatebandchamps.org. Just as with most campuses, there are obvious obstacles to maneuver. Please plan ample time to move your band.

Announcer

CSBC will provide an announcer who will gladly introduce your group and give follow up information about your group. All announcing must be done by the designated announcer appointed by CSBC. No school affiliated announcers will be permitted in the press box area as the announcer's area is in the adjudication area. Please do not ask for any exceptions to this rule as the CSBC is looking out for the integrity of the event. Announcer scripts are generated from the information provide via Competition Suite.

Penalties

Please see the penalty sheet and full set of rules and regulations posted on our website www.calstatebandchamps.org

Any rude/inappropriate behavior demonstrated by any director, staff member, student or spectator affiliate of any unit that is reported to either Head Judge by the Host High School Band Director shall be subject to a penalty of up to 5 points (Anywhere between 1 and 5 points depending on the severity of the situation) for the unit in question. Please instruct your students, staff, and chaperones, to be patient, and conduct themselves in a professional manner when parking, performing, entering, and exiting the stadium. CSBC and all the Host High Schools look forward to a smooth-running event.



PLEASE AVOID THE USE OF CONFETTI, FIRE, OR ANY OTHER ITEM THAT CAN BE SENT OUT INTO THE AIR. OPEN FLAMES ARE NOT PERMITTED, AND OTHER ITEMS SUCH AS CONFETTI MAKE IT DIFFICULT TO CLEAN THE TURF FIELD AND DOES NOT LEAVE THE FIELD IN GOOD CONDITION FOR THE NEXT PERFORMING GROUP. Failing to abide by the above rule may result in a penalty.

Video

Video recording is strictly prohibited due to copyright laws and there is not a designated area for video recording. Box 5 media will be providing videography this year.

Set Up Time

The deployment time for every band is 4 minutes. Bands will receive warnings during deployment at: 4 Minutes, 3 Minutes & 1 Minute. If the band is not ready at the end of the deployment period, your school will be welcomed onto the field and timing will begin. This rule is in place to keep the competition fair to all participants and to keep us running on time.

There will be no perusal period prior to any award ceremonies for Division Finals or Finals. All scores will be final. Judges will be recognized over the P.A. and released to their respective breaks or to go home at the end of their long days. Recaps will be released to the scores page of the website at the conclusion of the awards ceremony. Individual scores will not be released prior to the awards. All results will be considered final. We have a new follow-up procedure in place this year that has been working well, and we will respond to your concerns to the best of our abilities.



Division Finals Awards for each division will be <u>student leaders only</u>.

Band Directors should be on the track near the 50-yard line for introduction. We gave out Director Gifts at semi-finals this year, so it will just be a brief recognition time this year.

State Finals Awards (evening) will be <u>FULL UNIFORMED RETREAT!</u>

Please help us make Finals awards something special by putting your kids back in uniform. We will march every unit out onto the field and present the final awards. Please stay with your band and march in with them. You will put your band in performance order in the field area slightly behind and adjacent to the band entrance gate. Once your band is in the stadium, please come to the track so that we may recognize you (We would like to give you the shout out you deserve). Please instruct your student leaders to pull forward to the front sideline once the band is "parked." This will allow them to get forward and receive awards faster. Band line-up at Huntington Beach Site will be back by the gym. Band line-up at the Newport Harbor site will be the guard warm-up field directly behind the home side bleachers.

Post Performance

Please adhere to host school directions on where to sit after you have performed.

<u>Rain</u>

Those of you that know me and have been around know that it has only rained twice in all the years I've been doing this. It doesn't rain on Finals Day!
