Greetings!

We are honored that your group will be attending our **Wilson Field Tournament** III on Saturday, October 11th at Glen A. Wilson High School. Please read through all the information and share what is appropriate with your staff, bus drivers, chaperones and boosters. If you have questions, please feel free to call or send me an email.

<u>NEW FOR 2025</u> - Due to vandalism in 2024, our stadium speakers do not work. There will be temporary speakers placed near the 50 for any and all announcements. Our lights are working this year though, so hurray!

<u>PARKING FOR BUSES</u>, <u>EQUIPMENT TRUCKS</u>, <u>DIRECTORS AND JUDGES</u> - Vehicles for the aforementioned must enter through the Countrywood Avenue gate. If your group needs to leave the tournament early, please let me know and inform our parking lot crew when you first arrive.

<u>SPECTATOR PARKING</u> - Because the parking lot will be reserved for buses, equipment trucks, directors' and judges' vehicles, your support staff (including instructors) and spectators are asked to park on the streets near campus.

GUIDES - Your group will be assigned a courteous Glen A. Wilson High School student or alumnus to guide your group on campus until after your group performs. They can help you find the restrooms, a rehearsal space, etc. They can also help you find your assigned seating after your performance. If there's anything you need, please feel free to ask your Guide to assist you.

<u>ADMISSION</u> - Students will receive wristbands that will allow them to sit it their assigned seating area. There will be a nametag for directors and wristbands for all your staff and a limited number of chaperones/equipment helpers (see below). Spectators can purchase tickets at the ticket window, in front of the Gymnasium. General admission is \$15, Children 5-12/Seniors/Military with ID are \$8, and Children under 5 are Free.

CHAPERONES/EQUIPMENT HELPERS - When you arrive, you will be provided with 1 wristband for every 10 performers for your parent volunteers. These wristbands will allow your volunteers to be admitted into the stadium. *Please do not ask for more*. We hope that you understand that gate admission is a major component for raising funds at our tournament. *Please share this information with your boosters*. We do not want any parents who are unhappy because they are unaware of this policy. This policy also includes assisting your group pushing into the performance field. EVERYONE ENTERING THE FIELD WILL NEED A WRISTBAND. Thank you for your understanding.

<u>VIP's (Directors, Staff)</u> - Gold VIP wristbands will be enclosed in your director's packet that you will receive when you arrive at our tournament for the staff that you had listed on your application. The VIP wristband will allow access into our Hospitality Suite and into the stadium. <u>Please do not distribute these wristbands out to your chaperones, equipment helpers, or bus drivers.</u>
This has been a problem in the past we and we would like to keep our hospitality suite free of distractions for all VIPs.

We are also aware of the importance of your administrators and significant others who support you by attending your competitions. If you need additional wristbands for these people, please let me know. If I know far enough in advance, I can mail them to you. Otherwise, I will leave the additional wristbands in your director's packet that you will receive when you arrive.

BUS DRIVERS - Please inform your bus drivers that we will allow them free admission as long as they have identification (uniform or district identification badge, etc.). **Please do not give them a wristband.**

<u>PERFORMANCE ANNOUNCEMENTS</u> - Per CSBC regulations, a tournament announcer will be provided. The tournament announcer will be making all announcements. If you have not updated your ENSEMBLE INFORMATION on CompSuite, please do so as soon as possible.

LOST AND FOUND - Lost and Found is located at the "Check In" window in front of the Gymnasium.

<u>WARM UP AREAS</u> - Units should warm up in any of the designated warm-up zones on your map: the "upper" campus (the south side of campus) or the "lower campus". Be advised that music played upstairs can travel as far as the stadium. If you have a relatively loud group, please have directional instruments face away from the stadium. *Interference with the performing group in the stadium will result in a 1.0 penalty per infraction.*

<u>FIELD ACCESS</u> - The Staging area will be at the blacktop courts on the West side of the stadium. Band + Guard will enter from the Northwest gate, while pit + props will enter from the Southwest gate. There will be a step-off guide there to assist you (See attached field map). Staging Area will be a silent zone: NO DRUMS & NO RIM CLICKS. Be ready to enter the field at the appointed time as stated by the Tournament Announcer. <u>If you are using any golf carts, ATVs or any other vehicles to transport equipment, they will not be allowed onto the grass.</u>

CSBC TIME LIMIT - Your performance time must not exceed 11 minutes.

<u>PERFORMANCE TIMES</u> - The times listed on the schedule are times that performances should be starting (not the time for the four-minute warning). Please make sure you are at the gate well before your performance time. You will be given your four-minute, and one-minute warnings *prior* to your scheduled performance time; your warnings do not start at the listed times.

<u>JUDGES' COMMENTARY</u> - Judges' comments can be found through CompSuite. Be sure to login to your account or download the app to access them.

<u>AWARDS</u> – Awards will be presented for each group for each division, each Auxiliary & Percussion for each division, and Overall awards in HIGH MUSIC, HIGH VISUAL, and HIGH EFFECT for the whole tournament.

<u>AWARDS CEREMONY</u> - To expedite the award ceremony, please limit the number of leaders you send to the Awards Ceremony. Your leaders will be asked to assemble in the northwest corner of the stadium (Band Staging Entrance) shortly after the last performance.

CONCESSIONS/SOUVENIRS - Please encourage your students and boosters to purchase food & programs. There will be other goodies for sale at our souvenir stands.

<u>VIDEOTAPING</u> - If you choose to use your own videographer, please instruct your videographer that there will be no access to electricity. There is no admittance inside the press box.

HOSPITALITY SUITE - You and your staff are cordially invited to visit our famous Hospitality Suite. Delicious food and drinks will be provided free of charge. It's a great place for directors and staff to relax and visit with colleagues. Once again, *please distribute VIP wristbands only to your instructional staff, school administrators, and/or significant other.* Only people wearing the gold VIP wristbands or directors badges will be allowed into our Hospitality Suite.

BBQ - The Hacienda La Puente Unified School District prohibits barbecues in the parking lots and other areas on campus.

NON-SMOKING CAMPUS - Glen A. Wilson High School is a non-smoking campus as is the entire HLPUSD.

<u>INCLEMENT WEATHER</u> - In the event of rain, the tournament <u>may</u> be moved inside the Gym. If it is raining on the day of the tournament, please call before leaving school for an update -- (562) 587-9308.






