There will be a percussion/winds critique following the last unit's performance. Sign up for critique will happen on the week of the show and close at 12 AM on the day of the show.

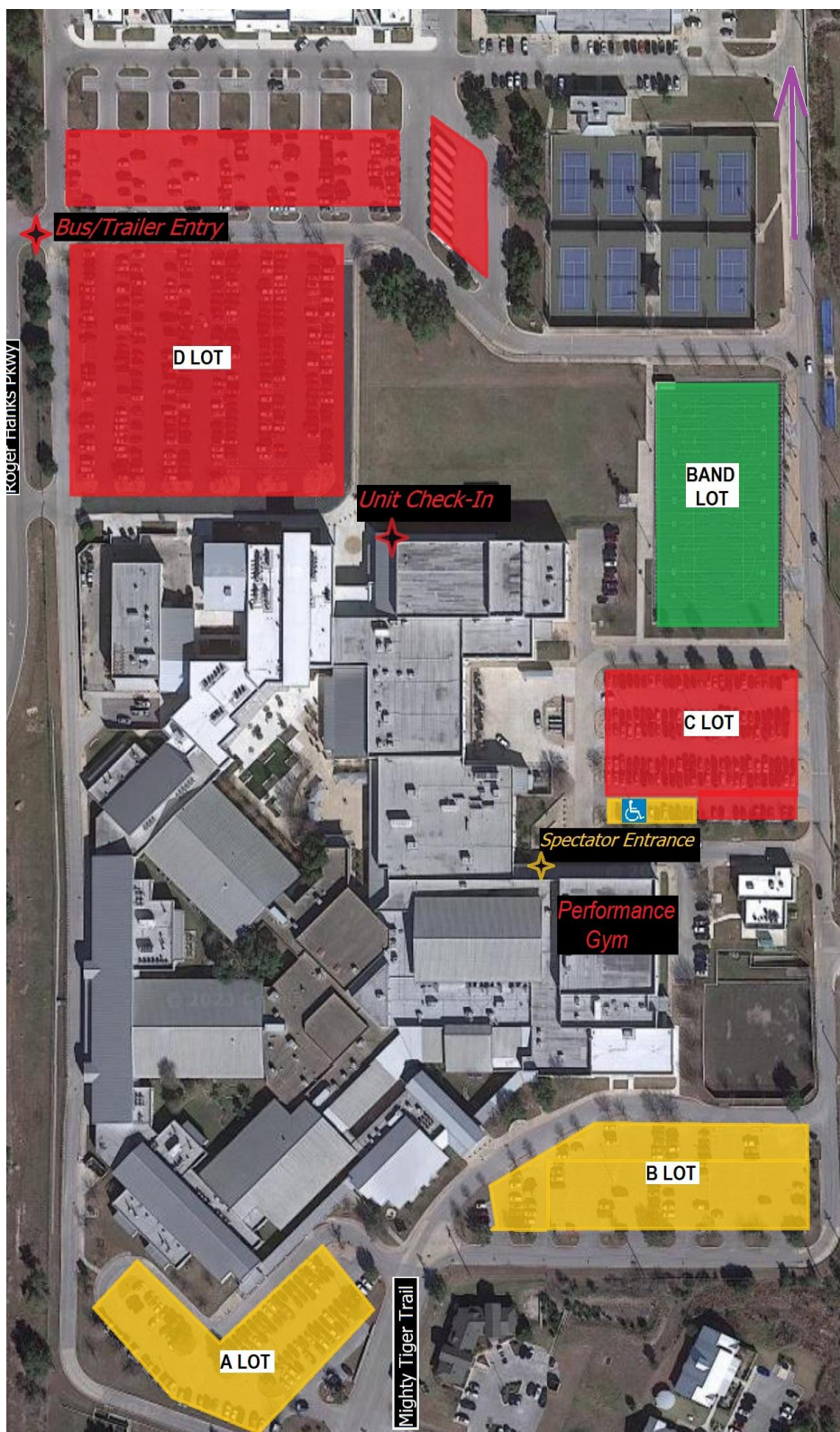
**VIDEO TAPING:** TCGC will do everything possible to provide a video of each performance.

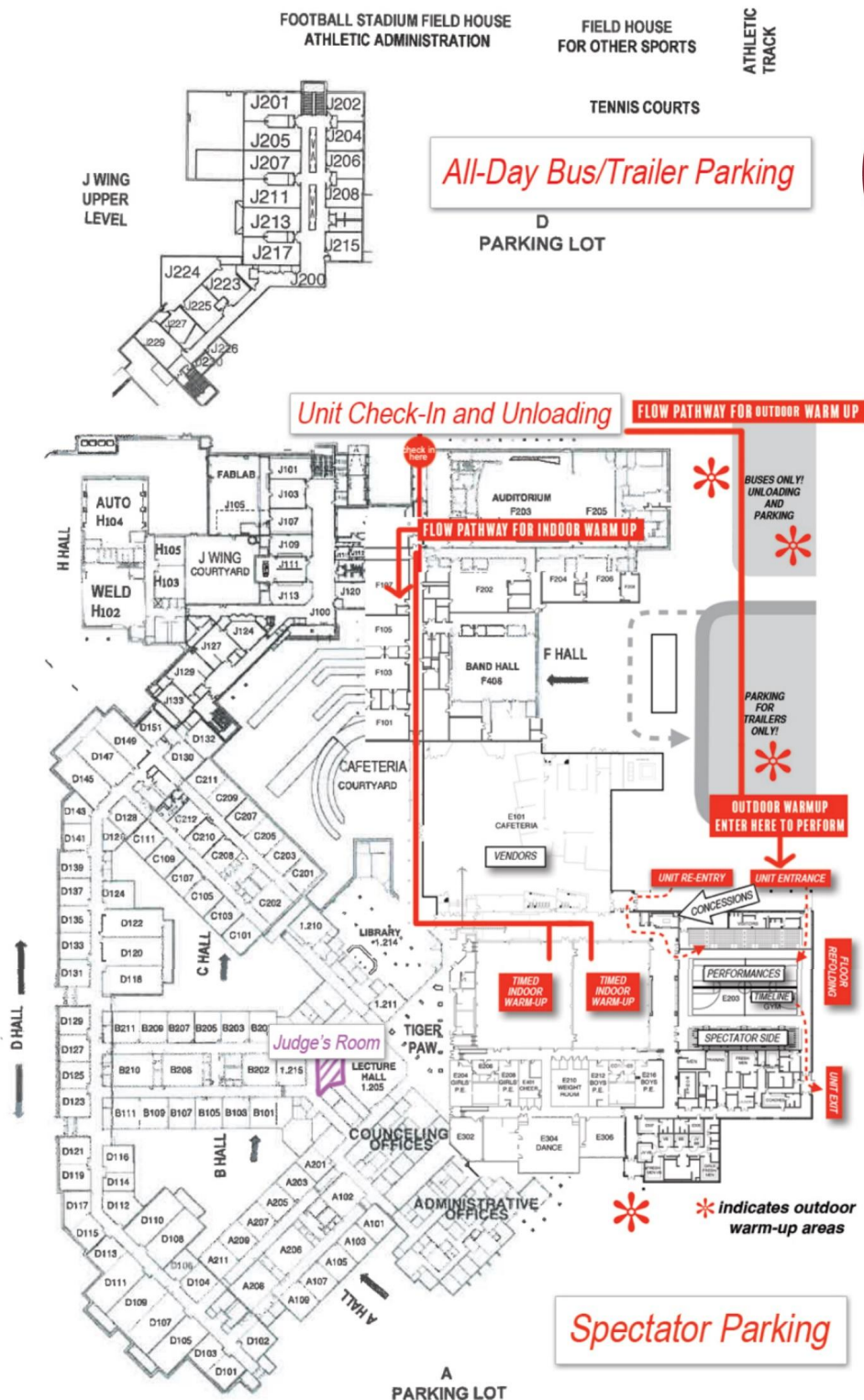

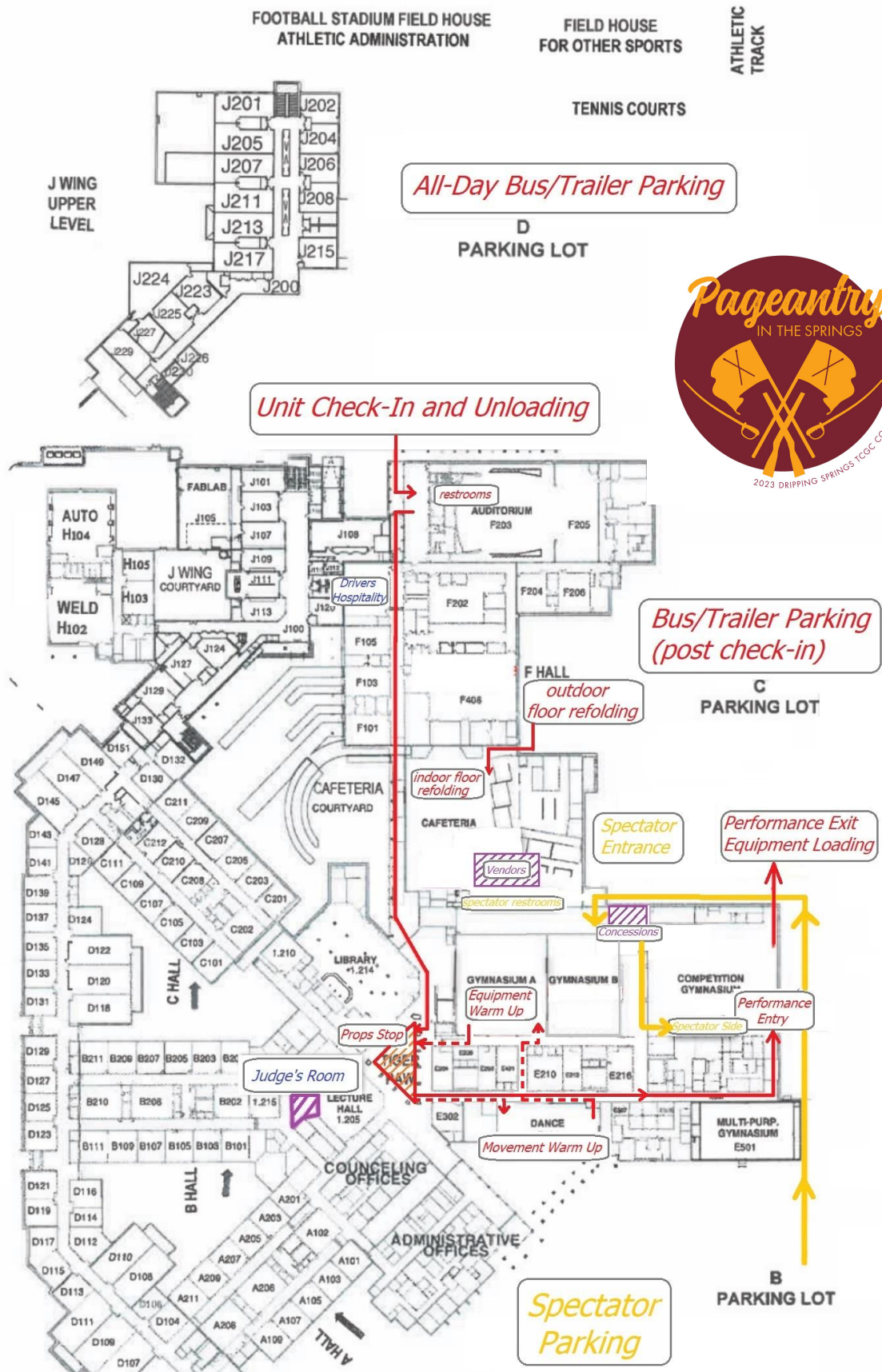
## PERCUSSION UNIT FLOW MAP

## DRIPPING SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL COLOR GUARD COMPETITION FLOW MAP

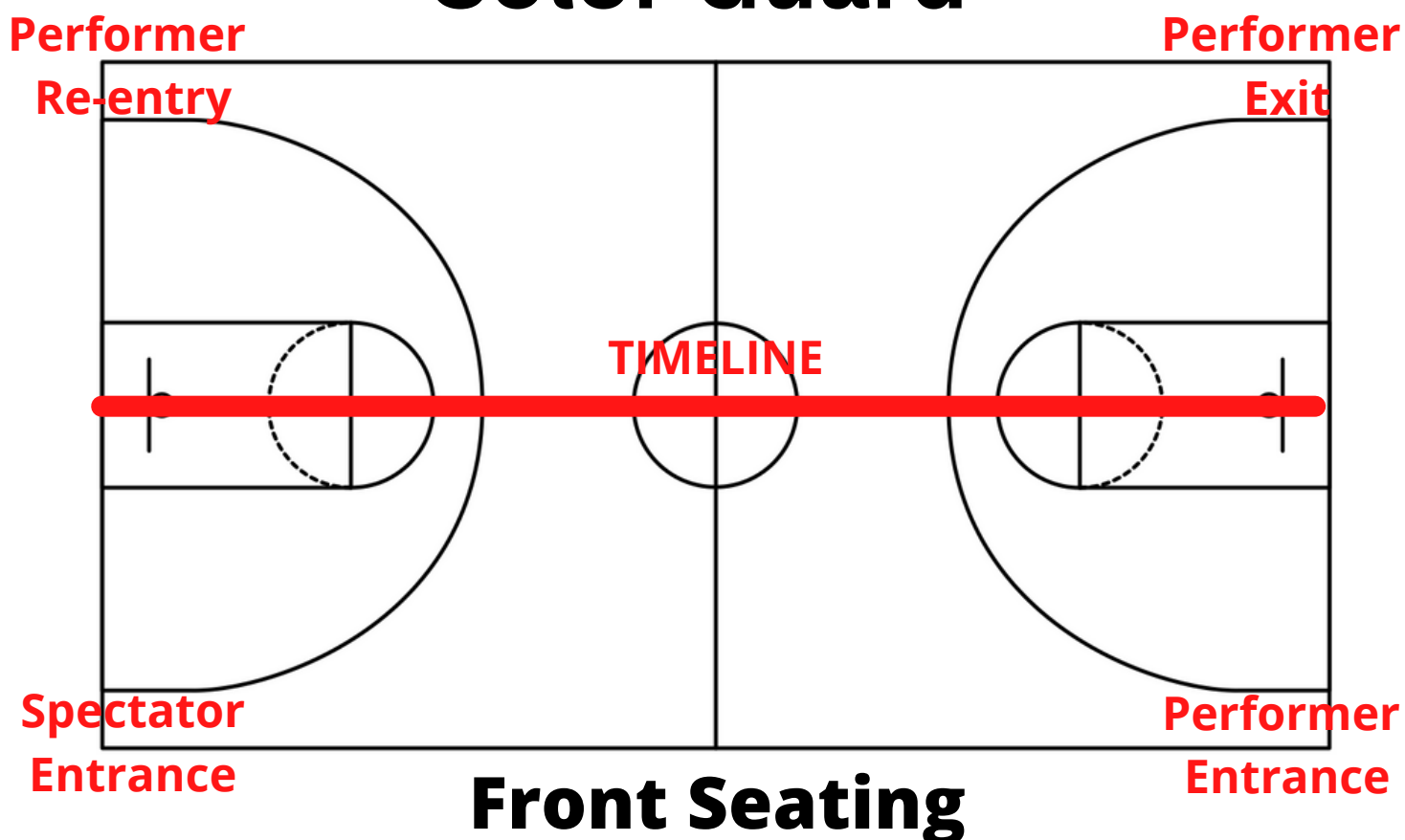




All TCGC contest sites shall have a minimum of 70' x 100' to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 78' x 106.'

The venue space at this event measures 62' X 118.' All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
