- Any additional Unit Badges your unit purchases must be accompanied by additional applications.

  - Unit staff members found in violation of this policy will have their badges revoked for the remainder of the season and disciplinary action will be taken against the unit according to the TCGC Code of Conduct.

**Front Side Bleacher Rows:** 14

**Seating Capacity:** 633 Approximate

- There are no permanent obstructions above the competition floor.
- Units do not enter the competition area directly from the outdoors.
- There is electrical power available at the front and back sideline.
- Units do not exit the competition area directly to the outdoors.
- The hallways will be utilized for prop storage prior to the competition.
- There will be a black vinyl tarp measuring appx 60' x 90' covering the wooden gym surface.
- An indoor space is available for floor folding.

**General Warm Up:** Very large outdoor courtyard area adjacent to cafeteria.

**Equipment Warm Up:** Small Gym, 101 ft long by 72 feet wide

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### Directions to Cedar Ridge High School 2801 Gattis School Rd, Round Rock, TX 78664

#### **From the South**

Take IH-35 North to Round Rock  
Take Exit 251-252A toward IH-35 Business/McNeil Road  
Merge on IH-35 Frontage Road  
Turn Right on Hesters Crossing Road  
Turn Left on S. Mays Street  
Turn Right onto Gattis School Road

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#### **From the North**

Take IH-35 South toward Round Rock  
Take Exit 253 toward Sam Bass Road  
Merge on IH-35 Frontage Road  
Turn Left onto W Palm Valley Blvd, Hwy 79  
Turn Right onto AW Grimes Blvd  
Turn Left onto Gattis School Road

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#### **From the East**

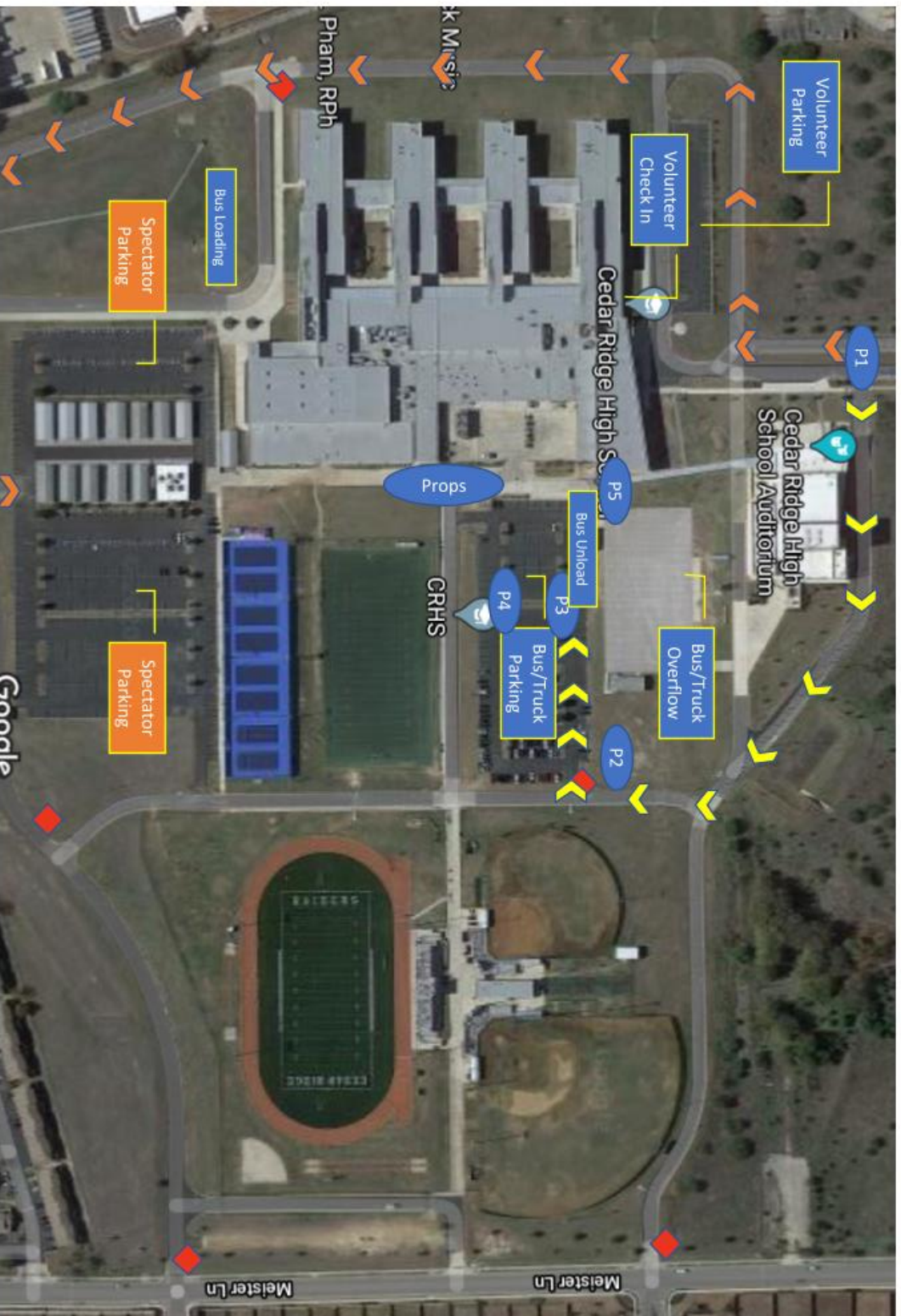
Navigate to SH-130 Toll (intersects with HWY 79, HWY 290 and HWY 71)  
Take SH-130 to Exit 425, Gattis School Road  
Turn Right and Crossover SH-130  
Continue on Gattis School Road until reaching destination

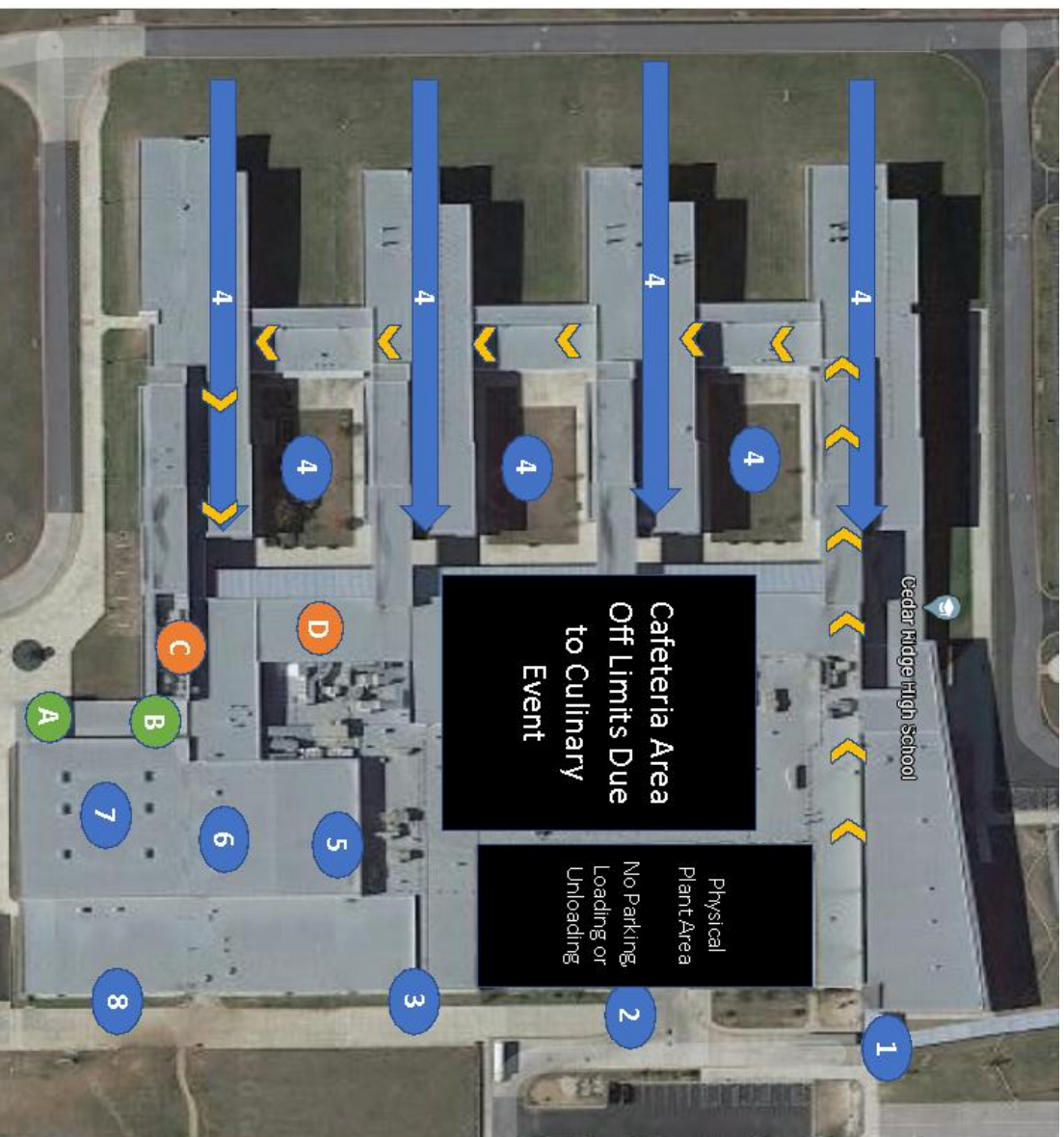

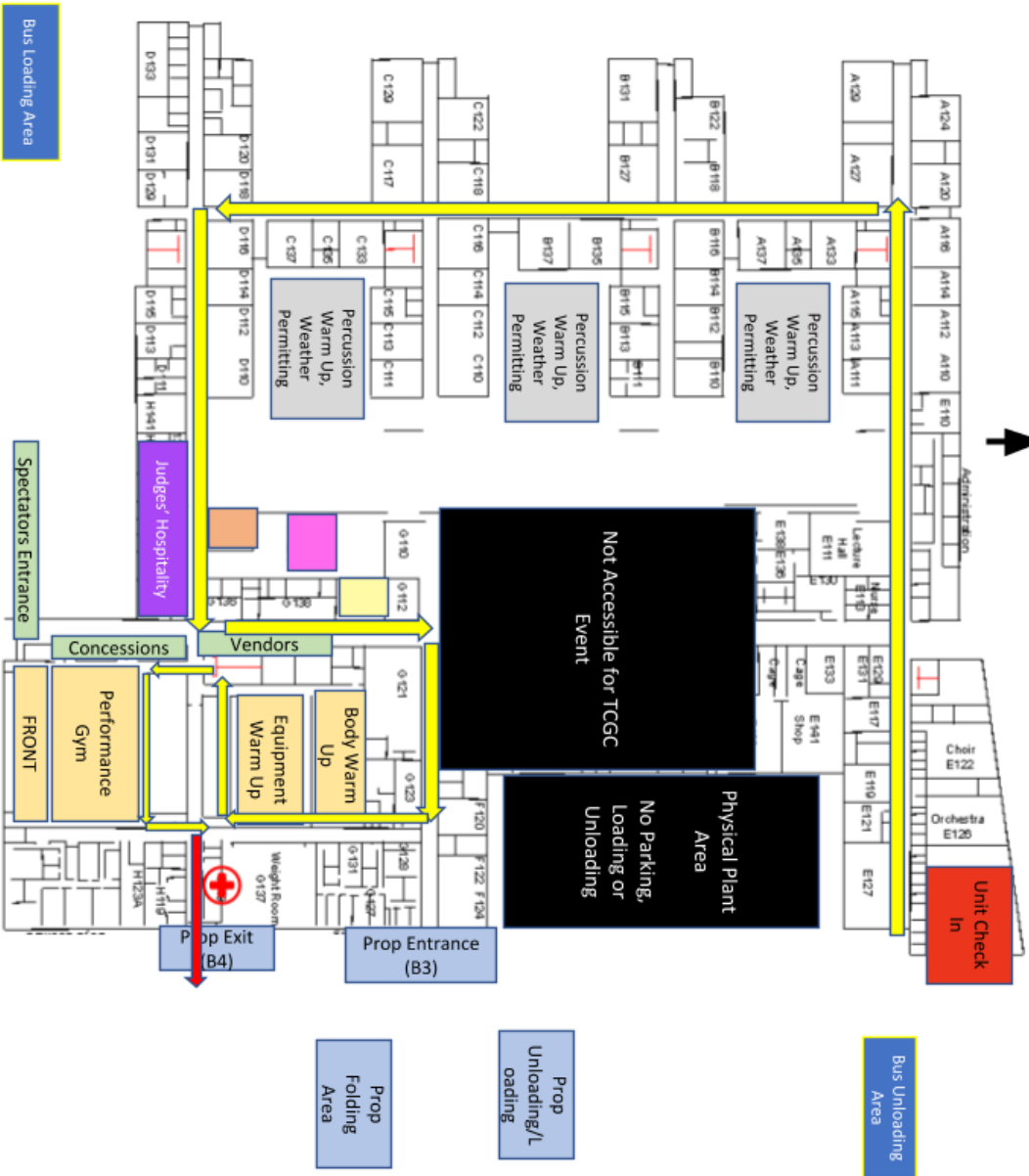

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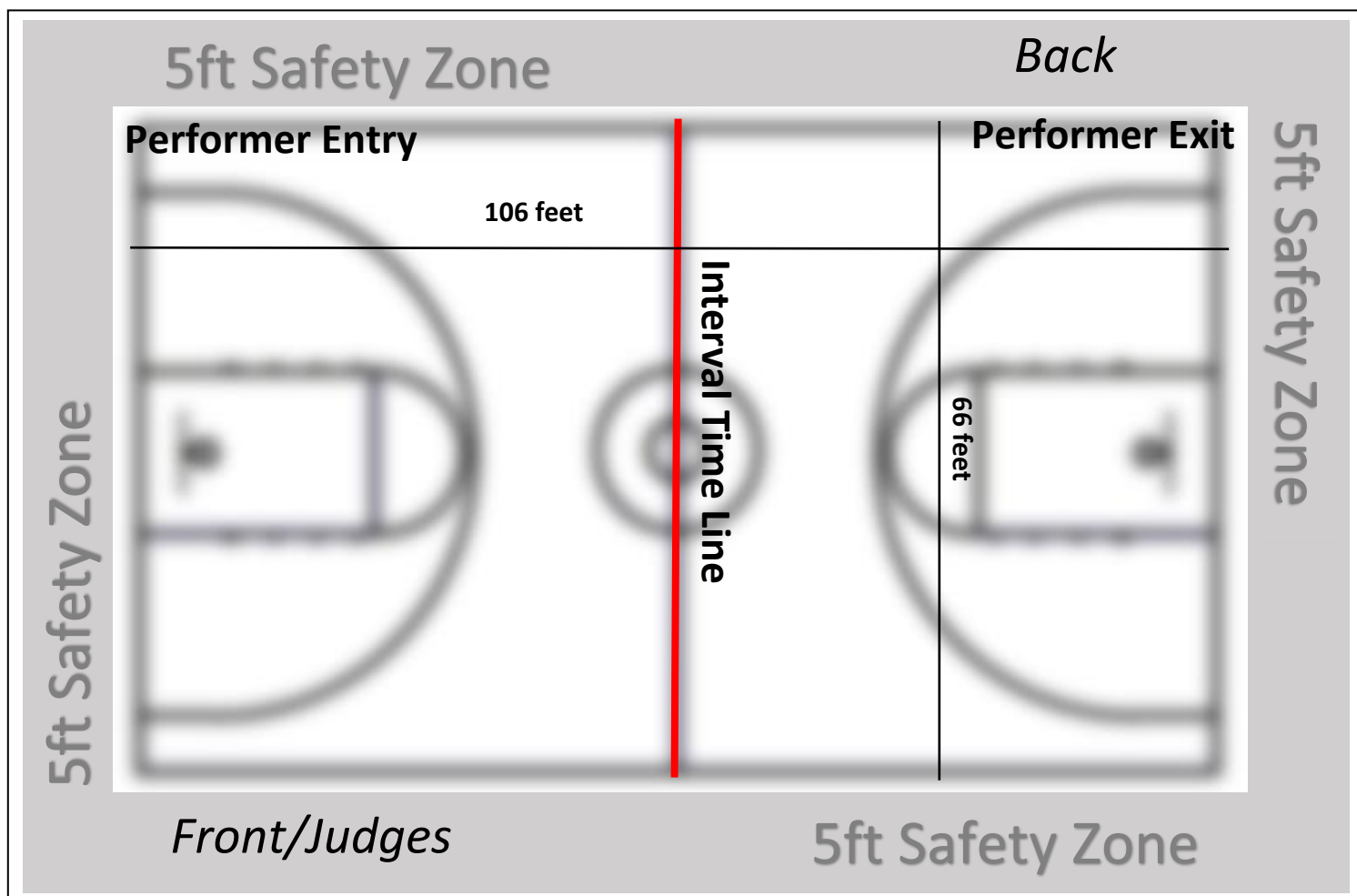


## Cedar Ridge HS Percussion

### Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 118' x 71'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 106' x 66'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
