WELCOME TO THE MORTON RANCH HS CONTEST!!!

All of us here at Morton Ranch HS would like to welcome you and hope that your visit to our campus and your first contest of the season is a successful one.

We have been working very hard to insure that the event runs smoothly and is as stress free as possible for you and your unit. If at anytime you have a question, please feel free to ask any adult or student volunteer. If we do not know the answer, we will find out. If you have any questions, please visit unit check-in in the Main Commons.

Unit Check-in will be located just inside the doors coming in from the bus parking area at the back of the school.

All buses will need to park in the parking lot behind the school next to the tennis courts and stadium. Enter on the WEST side of the campus and go behind the building then turn just prior to the tennis courts.

All color guard units have been assigned a classroom to prepare for the upcoming performance. Please help us keep our building in excellent condition by discarding any trash in the appropriate places and report any "accidents" to a volunteer so that it may be dealt with appropriately. NO FOOD SHOULD BE IN ANY CLASSROOM AT ANY TIME.

All floor carts and large props will be stored in the 1600's classroom hallways. There are no specific spaces assigned for this, simply find a blank section of hallway and store your carts/props until time to perform. We ask that after your performance all carts and props be returned to your bus/truck for storage.

The Main Commons will be used for color guard general warm-up. It can easily accommodate 3-4 units at one time. Please be fair and do not occupy this area for more than 25 minutes. No spinning will be allowed in any hallways as this would create a safety hazard. If you need additional warm-up time, there is lots of space outside. (Weather permitting)

A lounge for directors will be located across from the library in Room # 1324. A lounge for bus drivers will be located in the LGI which is on the 2nd floor overlooking the central rotunda. A first aid table will be set up on the Stage in the Main Commons (right by general warm-up) throughout the day.

We have a full concession stand next to the Main Commons/vendor area along with the "Maverick Café" for your enjoyment.

We do have a boxed meal option for performers of all competing units. This info was sent out in an email from TCGC on Jan. 16. If you utilized this option, you will turn in payment and pick up your boxed meals in the director lounge. (ROOM 1324)




DIRECTIONS TO MORTON RANCH HIGH SCHOOL

- ♦ Morton Ranch High School is located at 21000 Franz. Road in Katy, TX 77449. The school may be accessed from I-10 by using Westgreen or Mason Road and turning north. The school may also be accessed from Fry Road. (See enclosed map)
- ◆ For those using Westgreen or Fry Road: Take Westgreen or Fry Rd. North off I-10 to Franz Rd. and turn left. The school will be on your right. Bus parking entrance will be on the far side of the campus. Turn right into the driveway and then right again just before the tennis courts into the parking lots. Spectator Parking is in the front East side of the school
- ◆ For those using Mason Road: take Mason north off I-10 to Franz Rd. and turn right. The school will be on your left. Bus parking entrance will be on the near side of the campus. Turn left into the driveway and then right just before the tennis courts into the parking lots. Spectator Parking is in the front East side of the school.

PARKING:

- ◆ Automobile parking will be in the main (front) parking lot, just off Franz Road.
- ♦ ALL Buses should unload and park in the rear parking lots behind the school. Buses should enter using the West entrance off Franz Road, turn just before the tennis courts and proceed to the parking area. The parking lot attendant will show you where to actually park and leave the vehicle.
- ♦ Color Guard Equipment truck parking will also be in the rear parking lots behind the school. Trucks should enter using the West entrance off Franz Road, unload and move to the parking area.
- ♦ Percussion Equipment truck parking will also be in the rear parking lots behind the school. Trucks should enter using the West entrance off Franz Road, unload and move to the parking area. There is plenty of space in this area for outdoor warm up if weather permits.



Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred fee (70' \times 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 100' \times 70'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 90' x 60'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
