Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 111' x 77'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 100' x 77'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
