COMMENTARY:

SOUND TESTING:

One hour prior to the start of the contest and during breaks at the discretion of the contest director. Music should be uploaded to CompetitionSuite.

WARM-UP AREA:

All maps are in this packet. Please make sure you are at the timed warm-up area at the specific time even if you do not plan to use the space.

CRITIQUE: Units need to sign-up for critique through CompetitionSuite. We will not have on-site signup.

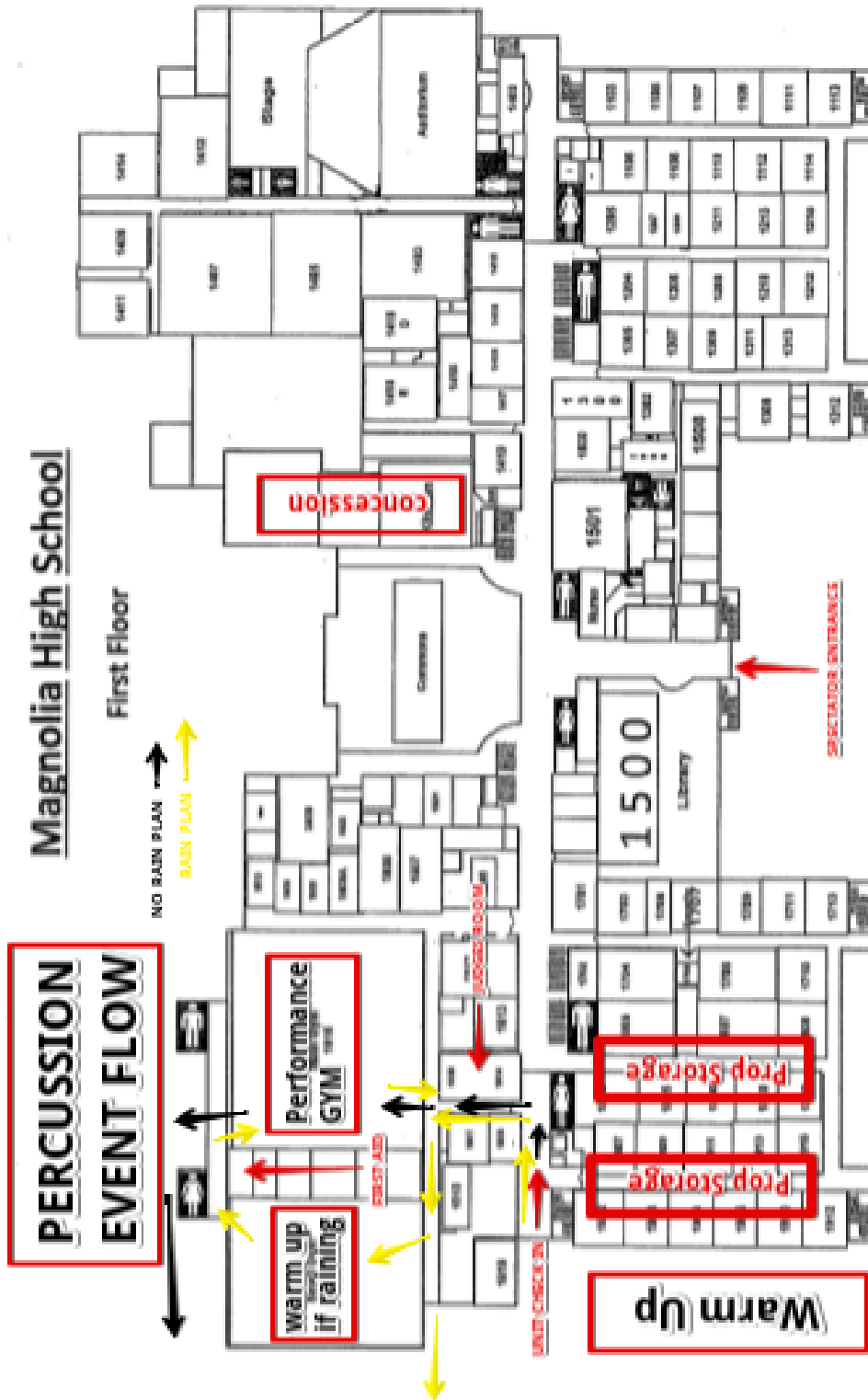


Magnolia HS Outside Flow



Timed Warm-up will be outside. This map has it labeled at “Warm-up”. There is an inside timed warm-up area if it is raining. This is a different flow than in past years in an effort to shorten the distance from trucks to performance and back.

Also, notice the rain plan. The flow inside the gym reverses to enter the indoor timed warm-up area as there will not be any inside general warm-up.

Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 100' x 70'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 100' x 70'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
