**CRITIQUE:** There is critique ONLY for those who have already signed up.

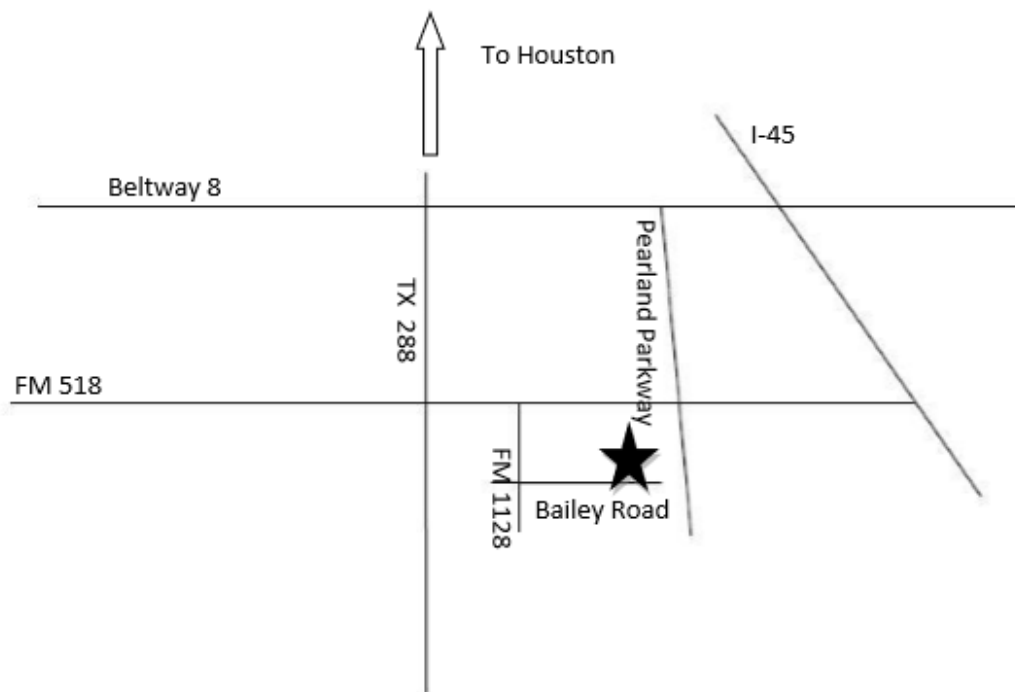
If you need anything please find a Dawson HS representative in a red shirt and we will do our best to help you!

**From North of Houston:**

Take Interstate 45 South through downtown Houston. Exit and turn right on Beltway 8. Exit and turn left on Pearlland Parkway. Follow around big curve to the left. Continue on Pearlland Parkway until it dead ends into residential area. (Pearland HS is on your right). Turn right. Pass Pearlland HS and go over large bridge. Turner HS is on the Right. Follow signs.

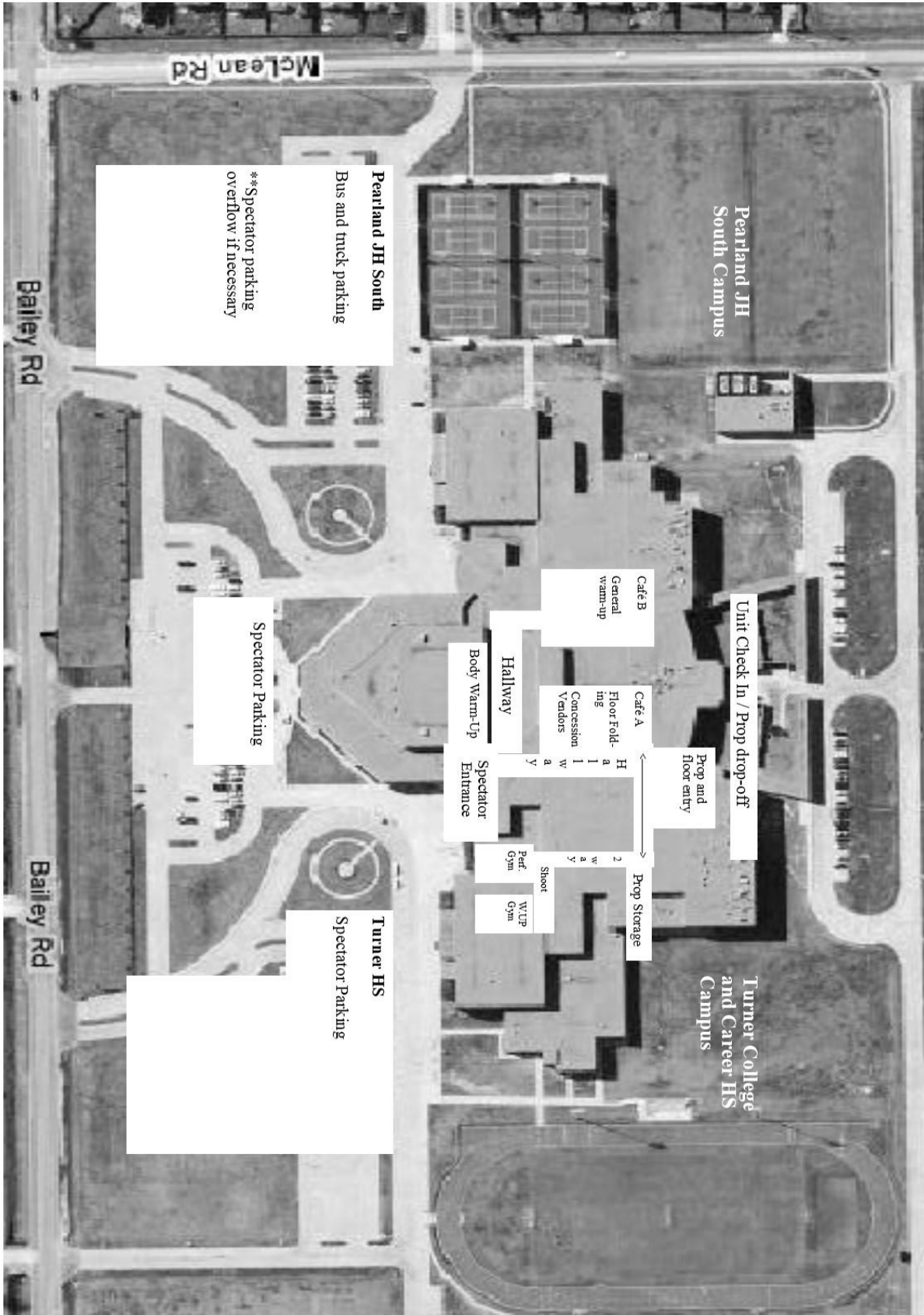
**From West of Houston:**

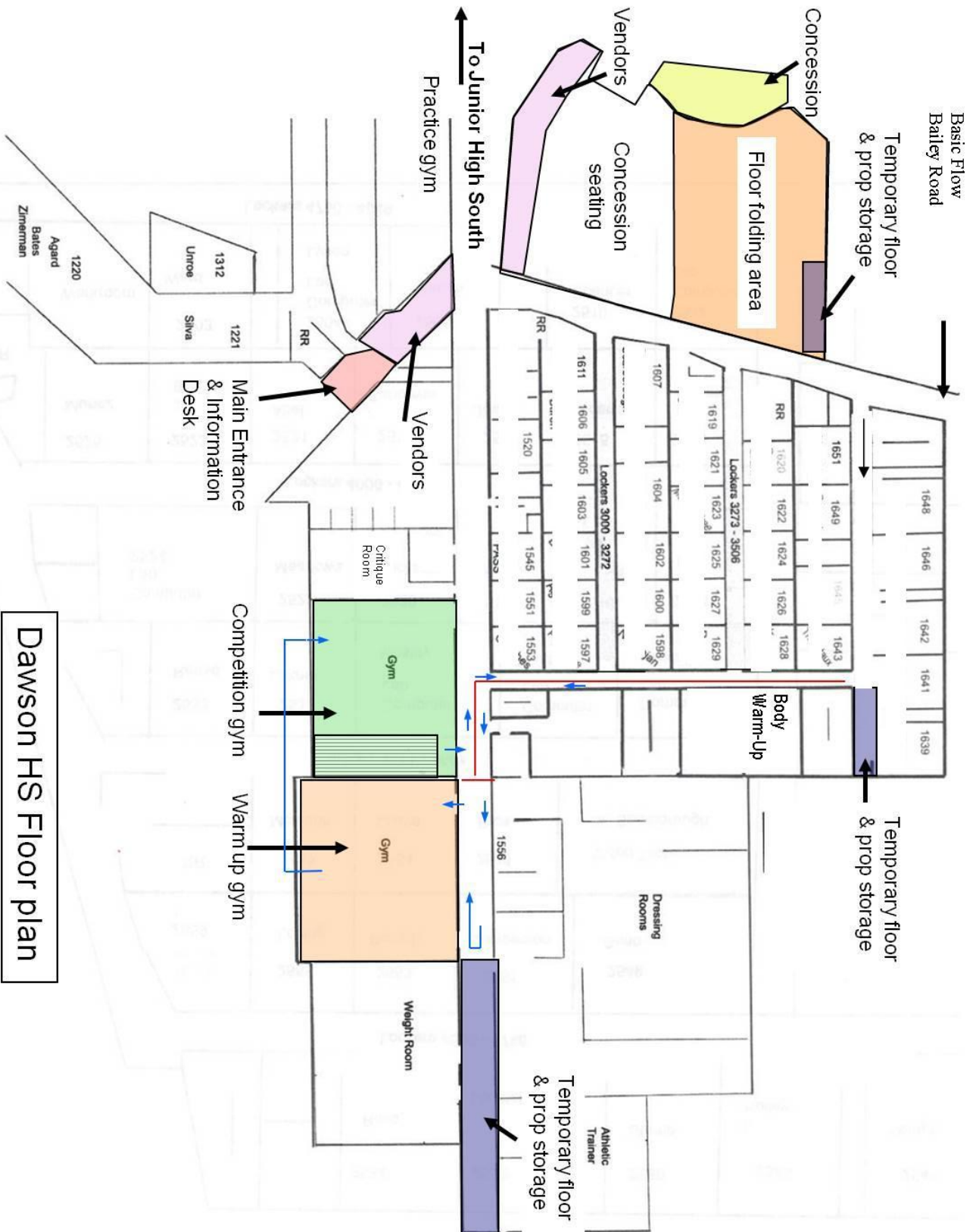
Take Interstate 10 from the Katy area. Take exit 756 to merge onto the West Sam Houston Parkway South. (This is a toll road.) Exit and turn right Pearlland Parkway. (Right after Telephone RD/FM35). Follow around big curve to the left. Continue on Pearlland Parkway until it dead ends into residential area. (Pearland HS is on your right). Turn right. Pass Pearlland HS and go over large bridge. Turner HS is on the Right. Follow signs.

**From East of Houston:**

Take Interstate 10, exit 781A to Sam Houston Parkway South. Exit and turn left on Pearlland Parkway. Follow around big curve to the left. Continue on Pearlland Parkway until it dead ends into residential area. (Pearland HS is on your right). Turn right. Pass Pearlland HS and go over large bridge. Turner HS is on the Right. Follow signs.

Dawson HS Floor plan

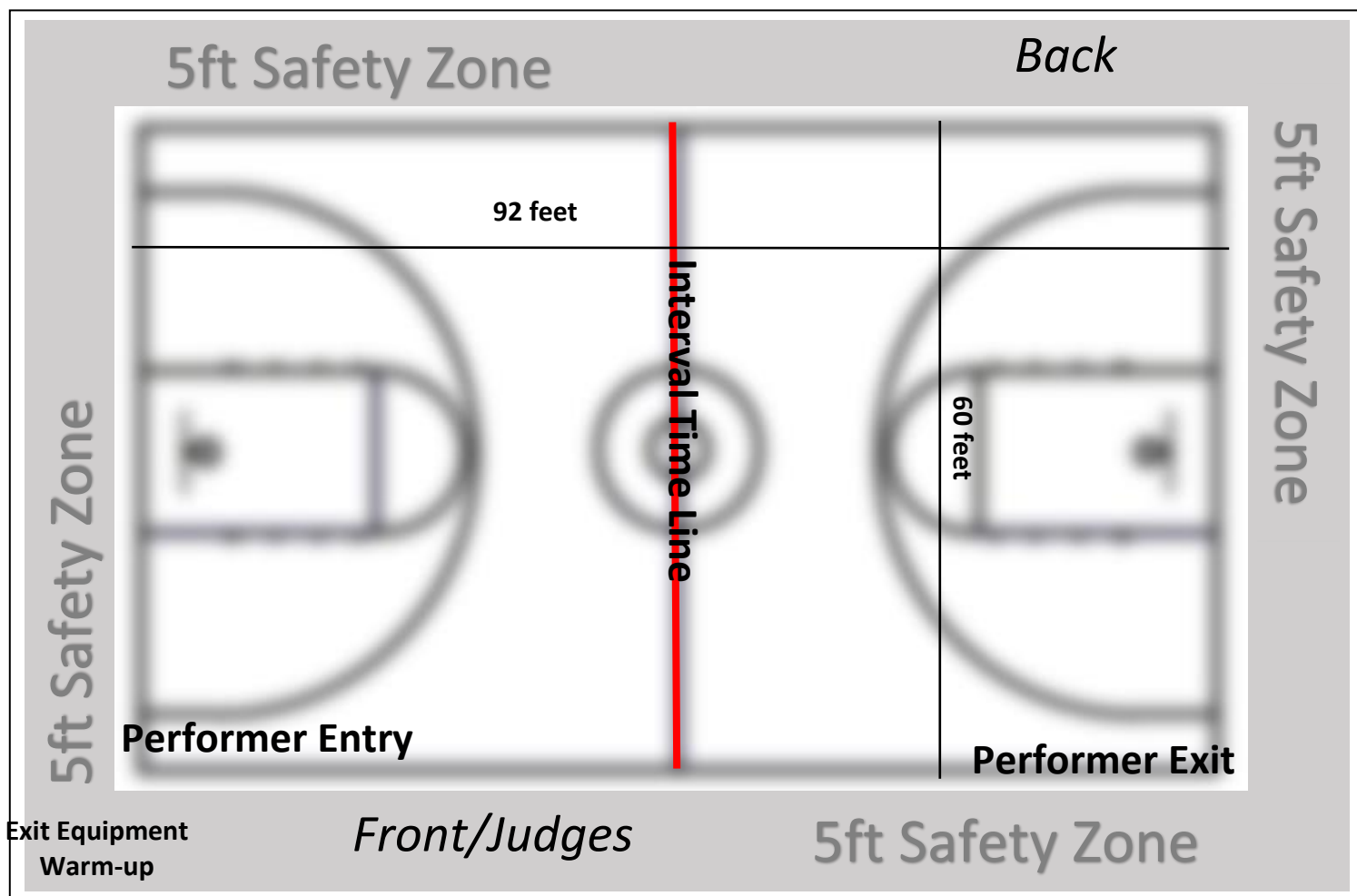


## Turner HS

### Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 102' x 70'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 92' x 60'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
