We have been working hard to ensure that the event runs smoothly. If at anytime you have questions, please feel free to ask any volunteer or visit the unit check-in.

Buses will need to park in the band marching lot located on the North side of the building.

Unit Check-In is located immediately upon entering the glass doors at the end of the breezeway.

Color Guard Units have been assigned hallway space to prepare for the performances. Please help keep our building in excellent condition by discarding any trash in the appropriate places and report any “accidents” to a volunteer so that it may be dealt with. NO FOOD or DRINKS should be in THE HALLWAYS AT ANY TIME.

Props – All floor carts and props will be stored in the Theatre Lobby. There are no specific spaces assigned. Locate a section of the hallway and store your carts/props until time to perform. We ask that after your performance all carts and props be returned to your bus/truck for storage.

General Warm up is located in the main commons area. It can accommodate 3-4 units at one-time. Please be fair and do not occupy this area for more than 25 minutes. No spinning will be allowed in any hallways as this would create a safety hazard. If you need additional warm-up time, please do so outside.

Directors lounge is located in the faculty dining room located in the unit check in hallway.

Bus drivers lounge is located in the choir room right next to unit check in.

First aid table will be setup in the orchestra room next to unit check in.

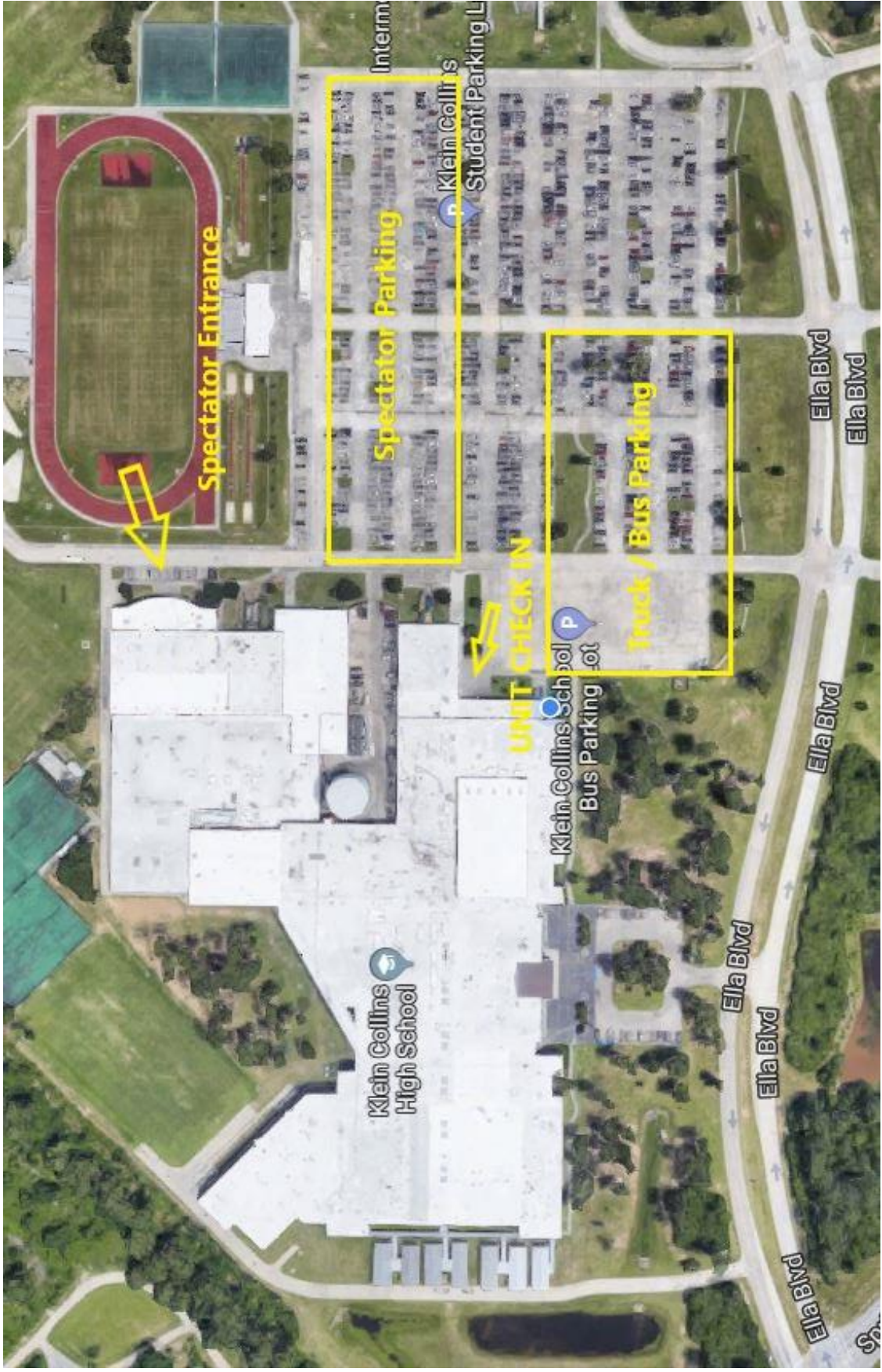
Concessions – full concessions available next to the Commons and a second location outside the performance gym in the lobby for your enjoyment throughout the day.

Competition Area

All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 114' x 80'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 104' x 70'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
