Each director should be set up with an account through CompetitionSuite. This is the ONLY WAY to receive judge commentary for any TCGC event.

**SOUND TESTING:** One hour prior to the start of the contest and during breaks at the discretion of the contest director.

**WARM-UP AREA:** All maps are in this packet. Units should arrive/check-in at the time on the schedule. Please be prepared to provide your own sound equipment in the warm-up facilities.

**RECAPS:** Recaps will be available online within 24 hours of the end event.

RETREAT: There will be a Guard/Percussion/Winds captain's only retreat(s) at the end of the contest as notated on the schedule.

**CRITIQUE:** There will be a pre-critique experience before the guard portion of the contest, and Percussion/Winds at the end of the percussion/winds contest. This will be determined on the judge's travel arrangements, and may only include a portion of the panel. You will sign up on the website for this on the week of the show.

Welcome to the 1st ever Mission High School TCGC Contest in Mission, TX. We hope that the information provided in this letter will make your day more enjoyable.

Thank you for choosing to support our show and we hope to host this event in a manner that will feel as close to a "normal" show day as possible. Safety of all participants is our top priority and Mission CISD protocols will be in place to ensure that we are conscious of the ever-present dangers that COVID involves.

As a reminder, per TCGC, we will not be offering a general warm-up space on the contest day. The floor folding space in located on grass, so if you will be reusing the floor on the same day, please be prepared to clean the floor before bringing it into the gym. Body warm-up is in our dance studio and contains mirrors on two sides. Equipment warm-up is in our smaller gym but has the same performance measurements as the performance gym. After the performance, locker rooms will be available for units to change and use the restrooms. Props, floors, and equipment should be loaded onto trailers/buses after each performance as there will be no holding space this year.

We have space for up to 1000 spectators in the performance gym and tickets will be available via a link on the TCGC website as well as day-of via a QR code. There will be no cash sales for tickets at any time.

Our Mission High School Band Boosters will be providing concessions for purchase and will accept cash or cash app. The full list of menu items are attached to this letter.

Each school will be allotted 10 bands for helpers. Additional bands can be purchased for \$3 each at check-in via cash, check, or cash app.



All TCGC contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred fee (70'  $\times$  100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to a maximum of 114'  $\times$  80'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 110' x 72'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
