Campus/Host Information/Description (include address, directions from nearest major freeway, day-of-show emergency phone contacts)

- 3901 W Linda Vista Boulevard, Tucson AZ, 85472. Host - Thomas Gerald, (520) 429-5162 for any event day needs.
- From I10 Heading East: Exit and turn left at Twin Peaks Boulevard. Turn right on Linda Vista just past the QuikTrip. Pass Mtn View, and turn right on Thornydale. Just before Overton is the service drive to the school where buses and trucks can enter to unload only.
- From I10 Heading West: Exit and turn right on Cortaro, and continue until Thornydale. Turn left on Thornydale, and just past Overton is the service drive to the school where buses and trucks can enter to unload only.

### Spectator Parking Location/Description

- Spectator Parking is in the front parking lot of MVHS accessible off of Linda Vista

Bus Unloading Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

- Bus Unloading is through the service drive that runs through MVHS, accessible via Thornydale. Buses should pull up all the way to the front of the drive along the right-hand side, and can unload there, and easily pull around to parking.

Bus Parking Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

- As buses leave the service drive, they should turn right on Linda Vista, and immediately right on Thornydale. They can turn right on Overton and bus parking will be in the Arthur Pack City Park parking lot behind MVHS.

Truck/Trailer Unloading Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

- Truck unloading is through the service drive that runs through MVHS, accessible via Thornydale. Trucks should pull up all the way to the front of the drive along the right-hand side, and can unload there and easily pull around to parking.

Truck/Trailer Parking Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

- As trucks leave the service drive they should turn right on Linda Vista, and immediately right on Thornydale. They can turn right on Overton, and truck parking will be behind the MVHS tennis courts, accessible through the loop behind the school.

## Unit Check-In Location/Description

- Unit Check in is in the service drive in the middle of MVHS. It will be located right outside of bus and truck unloading, immediately in front of our auditorium.

## Warm Up Areas A, B, and C Location/Description (indicate what direction units should face when playing, nearest shade/shelter from sun; one of your water stations should be located near the three warmup areas)

- Warmup area A is in our West Gym, past the tennis courts next to bus and truck unloading. The bar in the gym will be removed for easy access.
- Warmup area B is in our East Gym, directly across the sidewalk from our Fine Arts auditorium, opposite the West Gym and the tennis courts next to bus and truck unloading.
- Warmup area C is in our library plaza, accessible via the walkway behind our auditorium. Groups can follow the signs to access the warmup area via our bookstore plaza. The area is at the North end of the school, and groups should face North (towards the library) so as not to face towards the competition area.

## Stadium Spectator Entrance/Exit Location/Description

- From the spectator lot, visitors should enter the school through the student gate by the service drive, in between our two front parking lots. The stadium entrance is directly ahead, following the sidewalk along the service drive. Spectators can exit the same way.

## Stadium Spectator Restrooms Location/Description

- Spectator restrooms are located immediately behind the home bleachers, on either side of the concession stand.

### Stadium Performer Entrance Location/Description

- Performers may reenter the stadium through the same entrance used by spectators, and immediately on the right-hand side, along the tennis courts runs a path to the away bleachers that can be used to access performer viewing.

### Stadium/Field Unit Entrance Location/Description

- Units will enter the field through a smaller gate located next to the spectator entrance. Groups can use the walkway along the tennis courts to access the back of the field, and will enter the field from the North side, side 2, or the back. Front ensemble equipment and props can enter through the large gate immediately next to the winds/battery entrance and find a ramp to access the field directly in front of them.

### Stadium/Field Unit Exit Location/Description

- Units will exit the same side they entered on, as the stadium does not have an easily accessible exit on the South side of the field. Volunteers will be present to help direct traffic.

Stadium Unit Videographer Location/Description (All shows will provide a location near the top of the stands from which units may video their show.) Note: a videographer location is not needed at Sunrise Mountain, MCC, UofA Band Day or any of the championship sites.

- Videographers will be located immediately next to the press box.

### First Aid Location/Description (please consider access for emergency vehicles)

- First aid will be located adjacent to headquarters, outside of our Fine Arts auditorium.

### Water Station Locations/Description

- Water stations will be located on our tennis courts, at each warmup station, next to check in and headquarters, and potentially other areas around campus along the performer flow.

### Director Hospitality Location/Description

- Director hospitality will be located in our J/K building, directly across from the Fine Arts auditorium.

### Concessions Location/Description (also include information regarding whether you take cash/card, menu items, additional food vendors/trucks)

- Concessions is located behind the home bleachers, and will accept cash or card.

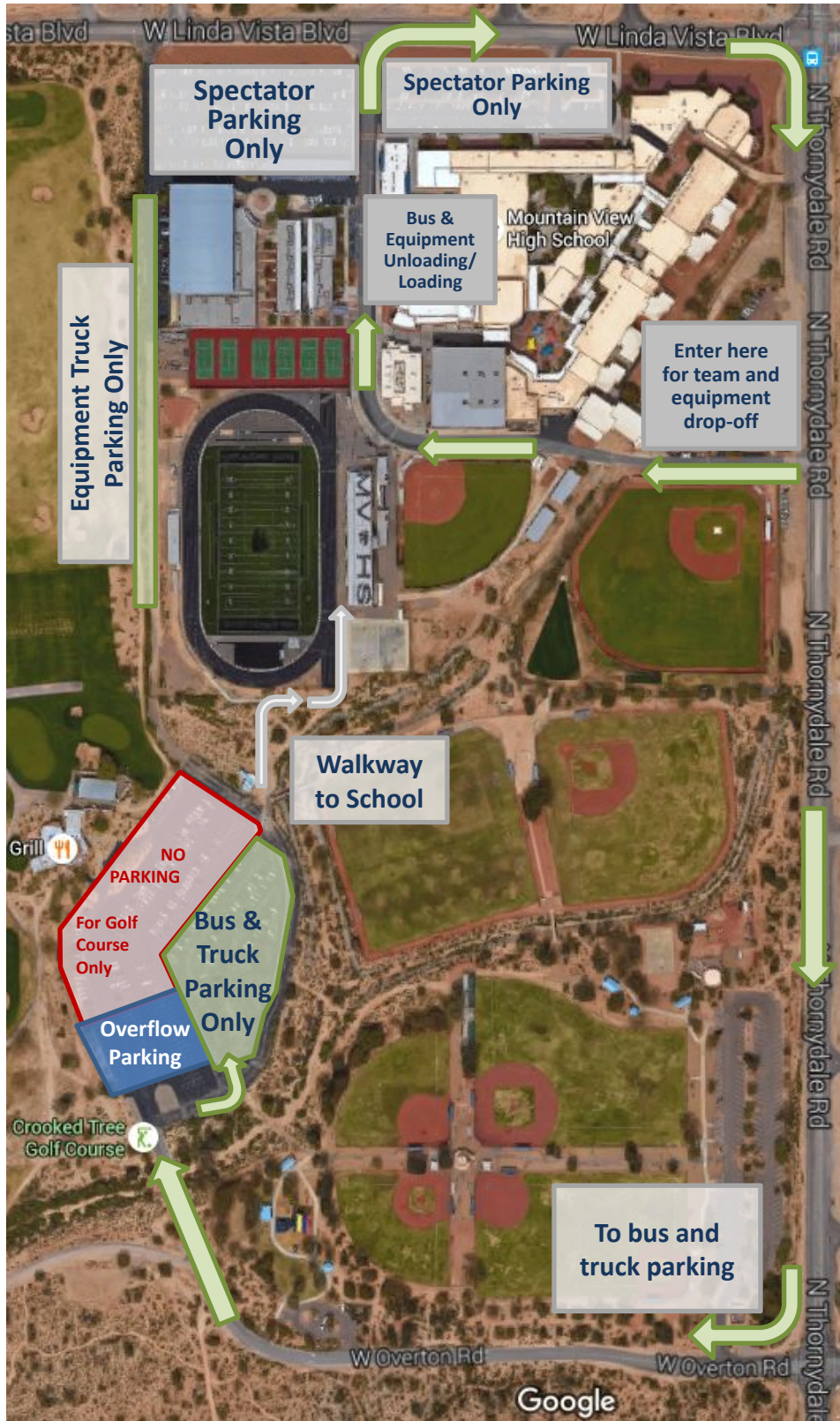
