Spectator Parking Location/Description

 Spectator Parking is located in our student parking lot on the south side of campus. From Prince Road, turn left into the parking lot via gate access east of Caballero Place. Signage will be present indicating spectator parking. Bus Unloading Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

Buses will unload in the parking lot at the end of Caballero Place. After exiting
I-10 at the Prince Road Exit (254), turn east on Prince Road. Once you pass the
pedestrian crossing at Iroquois and Prince, take your next left onto Caballero
Place. Continue on Caballero Place until the road curves left into a parking lot.
Unloading and unit check-in will be located in the northeast corner of that lot.

Bus Parking Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

• After dropping off in the lot at the end of Caballero Place, buses will continue to the left into bus parking lot. There will be an attendant present to assist drivers with parking. Be advised that there are angled solar panels in this lot. If this lot becomes full, overflow parking will be in a district lot off of Prince Road. Buses will exit bus parking going south on Pomona Road towards Prince Road. Turn left on Prince Road and immediately turn left into the overflow bus parking lot.

Truck/Trailer Unloading Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

 Equipment trucks and trailers will park in our staff parking lot on the northeast side of campus. After exiting I-10 onto Prince Road, continue down Prince Road and turn left onto Flowing Wells Road. Turn left onto Pastime Road. Please be advised that there are a couple of solar panels in this lot. An attendant will be present to assist drivers with parking. Please ensure no personal vehicles park in this lot unless they are pulling a trailer. Truck/Trailer Parking Location/Description (include any notices about height/clearance or ingress/egress restrictions)

Trucks and trailers will be able to park in the unloading area.

Unit Check-In Location/Description

• Unit Check-In will be in the lot at the end of Caballero Place where bus unloading is. A check-in table will be located in the northeast corner of the lot.

Warm Up Areas A, B, and C Location/Description (indicate what direction units should face when playing, nearest shade/shelter from sun; one of your water stations should be located near the three warmup areas)

- Warm Up A will be in our district administration parking lot, south of the stadium. Units should face south as they warm-up.
- Warm Up B will be in our JROTC parking lot, south of the stadium. This area is covered by solar panels. Units should face south as they warm-up.
- Warm Up C will be located in our community learning center parking lot, southeast of the stadium. Units should face east as they warm-up.

Stadium Spectator Entrance/Exit Location/Description

• Spectator entry and exit is located in the southeast corner of the stadium.

Stadium Spectator Restrooms Location/Description

 Spectator restrooms are located near the southeast corner of the stadium across from the concession stand.

Stadium Performer Entrance Location/Description

 Performers will be able to re enter the stadium from the southeast gate if coming from buses or the northeast gate if coming from the equipment lot.

Stadium/Field Unit Entrance Location/Description

Units will enter the stadium from the southeast gate.

Stadium/Field Unit Exit Location/Description

 Units will exit the stadium from the southwest gate. Front Ensemble and props will exit from the northeast gate to the equipment lot.

Stadium Unit Videographer Location/Description (All shows will provide a location near the top of the stands from which units may video their show.) Note: a videographer location is not needed at Sunrise Mountain, MCC, UofA Band Day or any of the championship sites.

A designated area for videographers will be located next to the press box stairs closest to the concession stand.

First Aid Location/Description (please consider access for emergency vehicles)

 First Aid will be located near the southeast corner of the stadium near concessions.

Water Station Locations/Description

• Water stations will be located: in between warm-up A and B, near warm up C, at performer entry, at performer exit, and at unit check-in.

Director Hospitality Location/Description

Director hospitality will be located in the west end zone.

Concessions Location/Description (also include information regarding whether you take cash/card, menu items, additional food vendors/trucks)

 Concessions is located in the southeast corner of the stadium. The Caballero Band Boosters accept cash and card.
