CHECK-IN

Please make sure you check in at least one hour before your scheduled performance time. You must make sure you receive your:

- Staff Tickets -** the staff listed on your program information will be the number of tickets you receive
- 10 pit crew passes -** all other parent helpers will have to purchase a ticket at Ticket entrance
- Students -** your students will be stamped/wristband when your bus enters our campus, see your host(s) with questions

PARKING

Buses may drop your band off at the designated warm-up area and then must proceed as directed to a parking spot near the warm up area or to the west lot for bus parking. If this All trucks/trailers may either unload their equipment at the band's designated warm-up area and then move to the pit truck parking lot or unload and park in the pit truck parking lot.

All general parking will be in the west parking lot.

WARM-UP

Warm-up A, and B labeled on the map are Timed Warm up areas. You will have a set amount of time to work on tuning and general warm up. Once out of these warm-up areas, **YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PLAY UNTIL YOUR PERFORMANCE TIME.** Sound travels easily throughout campus so do not play outside of your warm up area. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU FACE AWAY FROM THE STADIUM WHEN PLAYING IN WARM UP AREA.**

NO WARM UP IS ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF WARM UP AREAS AT ANY TIME—NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

PERFORMANCE

Each band is limited to a 15-minute performance time. This 15-minutes includes your field entrance, on-field warm up, show, and exit. **Bands will wait at the gate on the west side of the football field until the announcer introduces them onto the field, Your host will be there to assist as your band enters the field.**

Once the band enters the field, your time has started. After 2 minutes (13 minutes remaining) the announcer will ask if the judges are ready, and then will ask if the drum majors are ready, after the drum major salute the announcer will say, “you may begin your performance” and you are off. (If the judges are not ready time will be stopped until the judges are ready and the clock will resume once again.)

Minimum performance time is 6 minutes and the field must be completely clear of the performance area at the conclusion of the 15 minutes and the announcer begins introducing the next band. Completely clear indicates that all hornline, drumline, pit, colorguard, dancers and parent helpers have cleared the field.

PIT ENTRANCE

Power will be provided on the 50 home sideline. Please make sure that cords are ready to be plugged in our power source to cut back on time trying to find or untangle cords.

ENTRY GATES

All bands must enter through the west gate, on the visitor’s side of the field. All pit equipment should enter through the designated pit entrance north of the football field (see map). Colorguard/Auxiliary should enter with the band.

EXIT GATES

All band members, colorguard/auxiliary members, and pit percussion members will exit through the north gate next to the pit entrance gate.

RATING

ABODA sheets will be utilized with four judges for the overall performance and one judge each for percussion and auxiliaries. In addition ABODA will furnish a head judge to help with consistency throughout all ABODA qualifying shows.

SPECTATORS

This year there is an Admission Price of \$8.00 for adults and \$5.00 for children under 12 and senior citizens. Please let your parents know that if they do not have a Pit Crew Pass, or a general admission ticket they can't help with the on and off of your band. We are only allowing 10 Pit Crew Passes so all other helpers will need to purchase a general admission ticket.

Spectators will only be allowed to enter through the Northeast Entrance. Tickets can be purchased at the gate.

FOOD ARRANGEMENTS

All concessions will be located on the home side of the field.


DIRECTORS HOSPITALITY
