The MCGC Championships Committee will manage this event. Assigned volunteers will perform their duties at various stations as delegated by the Championships Committee. The contests could begin as early as 8:00 am; therefore, volunteers should be prepared to report for duty as early as 6:00 am. Volunteer duties conclude by 10:00 pm on Saturday and 6:00 pm on Sunday. We may need assistance with load-in (Friday evening) and strike (Sunday after 6 pm.) These times are subject to change, based on the number of units in competition. Forty+ workers are needed every shift for the contest to function smoothly and effectively. A shift system has been implemented in the past so that one worker does not need to work an entire day. Financial arrangements will be finalized upon acceptance of proposals.
