



Color Guard Instructor

Olivet College, a liberal arts college 30 miles southwest of Lansing, Michigan, seeks an **instructional staff person for color guard** beginning August 7, 2019.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The instructor will be responsible for designing and teaching color/winter guard at band camp and within the following course, which includes all home football games during the fall semester and basketball games during the spring semester:

MUS 160/260/360/460 Athletic Band (Band Camp is a requirement of this position and will be held August 7-16. Rehearsals during the fall semester are Wednesday, 3:00 – 5:00 PM & Thursday 6:30 – 9:00 PM)

***Prerequisite:** Audition and director approval is required.*

Catalog Description: The athletic band performs a contemporary repertoire and marching technique suitable for fall winter athletic events, while striving to maintain high standards of performance. The Olivet College Athletic Band offers numerous performance opportunities throughout the school year and represents the college in a variety of settings both on and off campus.

Band Camp is the pre-season component to this course.

The Athletic Band is required to perform at each of these events as well as homecoming events, and the annual Marshall Christmas Parade.

Candidates should bring the ability to create a positive classroom experience with an ensemble that is comprised of music majors and non-majors.

REQUIREMENTS: Preferably, interested individuals should have a Bachelor's degree in Music. Candidates should also have at least three years directing color guard ensembles and/or band at the high school and/or college level.

ACADEMIC SCHEDULE: Color guard instruction at Band Camp runs from August 7 – 16.

Home football games are currently scheduled for: September 21, October 12, October 26, November 16.

The basketball schedule is planned during the fall semester.

Fall classes run from Monday, Aug. 19 through Friday, December 6.

Spring classes run from Monday, Jan. 6 through Tuesday, Apr 21.
