# Unit/Performer Instructions

## **AT A GLANCE...**

- All performer and equipment unloading takes place in the **SOUTH parking lot**
- Units may **not** open performance floors outside of the performance space
- Guard timing line is VERTICAL
- Percussion timing line is HORIZONTAL
- Flash photography is **prohibited** in performance areas
- Video recording is **prohibited** (except for a unit's private review purposes)
- Food and drink (except bottled water) is not allowed inside any WHFS gymnasium

## **Show Location and Directions**

- Location: Williams Field High School  
2076 S Higley Rd  
Gilbert, AZ 85295
- Directions: Travel on US 60 or Loop 202 San Tan freeways **EAST to Higley Road**  
Proceed **SOUTH past Ray Road**  
WFHS is on the WEST side of street

## **Arrival and Check-in**

- **All performer and equipment unloading takes place in the SOUTH parking lot**
  - Drivers may use the driveway south of the traffic light to avoid sharp turns at the main entrance
  - After unloading, buses/vehicles will park in the north parking lot
- Directors check in at the unload point to receive their packet (contents listed on the cover letter)
- Wristbands for performers and support staff should be distributed upon receipt

## **Performer Warm-up**

- Percussion units warm up in the south parking lot adjacent to the check-in area
- Guard units warm up along the outside edges of the central courtyard ("the Nest")
- **Units may not open performance floors outside of the performance space**
- Percussion units must remain quiet once they leave the warm-up area

## **Inspection/Entrance and Exit**

- Percussion inspection is in the breezeway on the south side of the performance area (main gymnasium; shown on map)
  - Equipment hanging from pit instruments may not touch the floor
  - All props that touch the floor must have edges taped (per WGAZ policy)
- Guard inspection is at the north entrance to the auxiliary gym (shown on map)
  - Equipment ends must be taped
  - All props that touch the floor must have edges taped (per WGAZ policy)
  - Guard units will enter the performance area (main gymnasium) from the auxiliary gym
- All units exit through the northeast door of the performance area
- Floors may be folded in the center of the central courtyard ("the Nest"; shown on map)
- Equipment loaded in the north parking lot (shown on map)

# Unit/Performer Instructions

---

## Inspection/Entrance and Exit *(continued)*

- All inspection/entry and exit doors will have center posts removed to facilitate easier movement of instruments and/or props
  - Please note that center post base assembly cannot be removed from the exit door and may pose a hazard – show volunteers will be available to caution performers as they exit
  - Individual door measurements
    - Percussion inspection/entry – 67 ¾" W x 78" H
    - Guard inspection – 74 ¼" W x 79 ½" H
    - Guard entry – 72" W x 79 ½" H
    - Performer exit – W 70 ½" x H 79 ½"
  - *Door heights can be increased 1"-2" with removal of additional door hardware – please email the local Show Host Coordinator if needed*

## First Aid / Emergency Medical Needs

- Performers in need of first aid should come to the area adjacent the Admissions booth
- Black Hawk Band Boosters is equipped only to handle minor first aid issues (i.e. minor cuts, scrapes, bumps/bruises, minor strains/sprains)
- Black Hawk Band Boosters may, at its own discretion and per WGAZ policy, determine that an injury is beyond our scope of care and requires professional medical attention

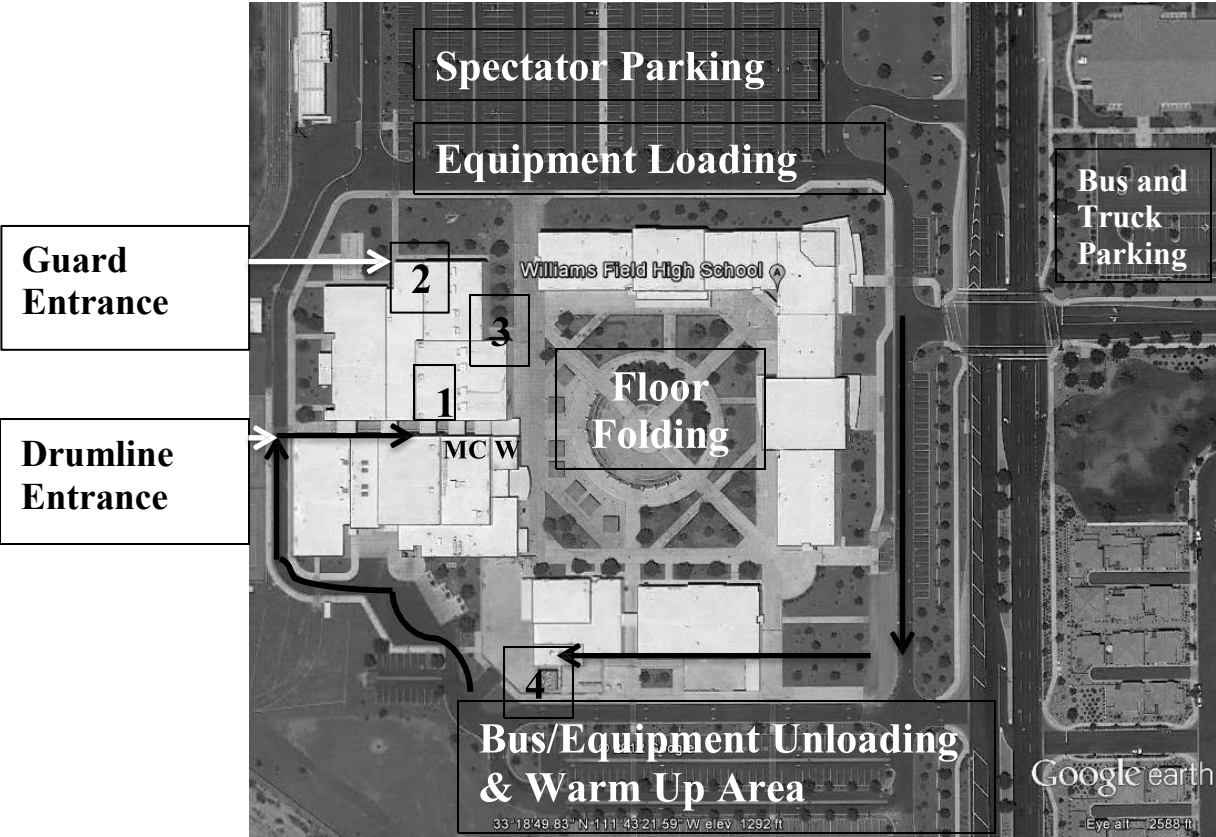

# Williams Field High School Site Map

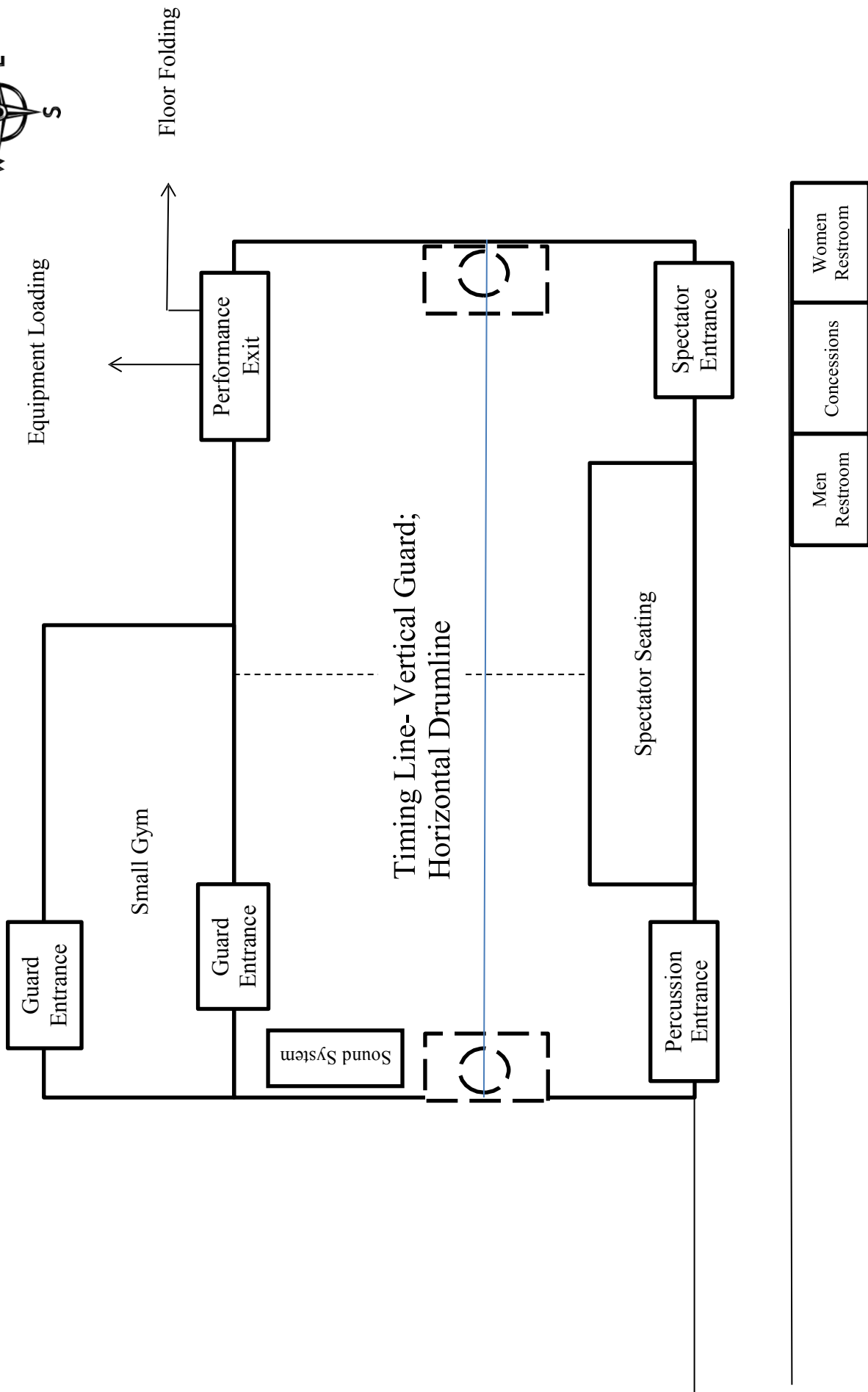

## Show Location and Directions

### **AT A GLANCE...**

- Spectator parking is permitted only in the **NORTH parking lot** (adjacent to the stadium)
- Admission is \$8 per person; Student/Senior is \$5 per person; children 5 and younger are free
- Food and drink (*except bottled water*) is not allowed inside the gymnasium
- Video recording and flash photography are **prohibited**
- Black Hawk Band Boosters relies heavily on concessions sales to support our programs – **please no outside food or drink (except bottled water)**... thank you!

## Arrival and Parking

- Spectators may enter the site at the traffic light or using the two driveways to the north of the main entrance
- Spectator parking is permitted only in the **NORTH parking lot** (adjacent to the stadium)

## Admissions

- Spectator wristbands are purchased at the Admissions booth and are required to enter the performance space
- Regular admission is \$8.00 per person
- Student/Senior discount admission is \$5.00 per person
- Children 5 and younger are admitted free
