Campus is located off Rural Road between Warner and Ray. Easy to get to from either the I-10 or the 101 using the Warner or Ray exits.

Units Park in parking lot on Knox Road on the north east side of the campus. This will include buses, trailers and regular vehicles. Only Units will utilize this parking lot. Spectators use the parking lot right off Rural Road on the south west side of the campus.

Admissions:

Spectator Tickets are \$8 each with kids under 5 free. Student tickets are \$5. Cash and cards will be taken with no additional fees to use credit or debit cards. Spectators will receive a wristband for entry into the gym and these must be worn.

Programs:

Also, flower and candy grams will be available for purchase for \$2 which will be given to your performer right after they exit the gym. This is an immediate way to congratulate your performer.

Flash photography is not permitted in the performances areas. Each unit may videotape their only in the designated area. Please do not videotape any other unit and please share this information with others.

Concessions:

Please note that food and drinks are not allowed inside the gyms.

First Aid:

First Aid area will be located just north of the gyms with access to the spectators and the Unit practice areas.

Unit Check In:

Units will check in near the Knox parking lot. Units will be provided a packet with wristbands for each performer and an additional 7 wristbands for directors and volunteers. Additional wristbands can be purchased at Admissions for \$8 each. Wristbands must be worn by performers at all times.

Units will also be assigned a Unit Host who is a student at Corona with knowledge of the campus.

A floor and prop storage location will be established near the Warm Up Gym. A monitor will be at the area to organize and guard the equipment until the Units need them for performance.

Director Hospitality:

Directors are welcome to gather in the Hospitality Area which will have drinks and snacks available.

Practice Areas:

Guard Units will rehearse in the fields when they arrive. Percussion groups will be placed around the campus between Unit Check in and the Gyms. There will be a water station at the Guard practice area, two within the campus and one upon exiting the gym after performances are completed. Practice areas and water stations will be pointed out by the Unit Hosts upon check in. Units can only open performance floors on the outside courts if they are on top of a practice floor, but it must be marked as a "Practice" floor.

Inspection and Final Practice:

Inspection and final practice will take place in the Small Gym. Unit Hosts will escort the Units from the practice areas at the designated times to the Small Gym and then from the Small Gym into the Large Gym for performance.

Floor Folding:


The floor folding area will be on the basketball courts outside the Large Gym exit. The Unit Host will direct the Units to the location. From the folding area, Units can walk back to the Knox parking lot around the outside of the main building to store equipment before returning to the Gym to watch.

Unit Seating:

After Units perform, they will be welcome to come back into the Large Gym to watch the rest of the performances. Unit Seating will be at the second level on the north side of the gym. Door monitors will be available to direct Units to the location.

Awards:

There will one award ceremony at the end of the event. Unit captains will meet in the Small Gym at the conclusion of the last performance to be placed in line and escorted into the Large Gym.
