Directions:

East valley schools - take I-10 West to 303 North to Bell Rd. Exit on Bell turn left, travel west to Citrus. Turn left on Citrus. Turn right on Lundberg and then turn first left. Bus loop located on left next to bus parking.
West Valley Schools: - Take I-10 East to 303 North to Bell Rd. Exit on Bell turn left, travel west to Citrus. Turn left on Citrus. Turn right on Lundberg and then turn first left. Bus loop located on left next to bus parking.

Check-in: Directors will receive their directors packet at check-in. In this packet, directors will be given 7 staff wristbands for staff. Additional staff/helper wrist bands can be purchased at the check in table. All performers will be given a wrist band.

Truck/Bus Parking: Buses and equipment vehicles will off load on the west side of campus in the bus loop. Trailers will go to the opposite side of campus to park. Buses will park in the bus parking and remain there until the duration of the event.

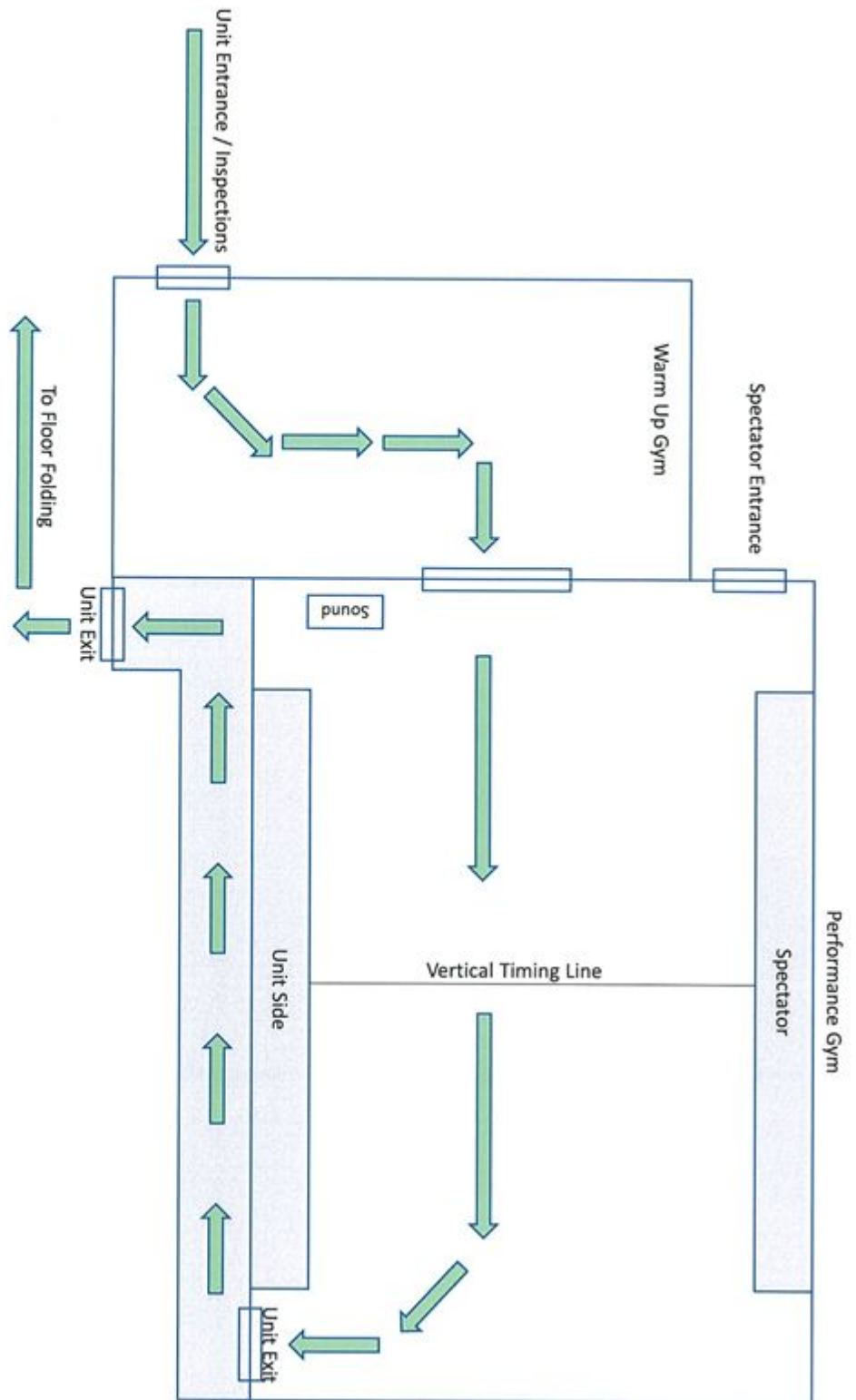

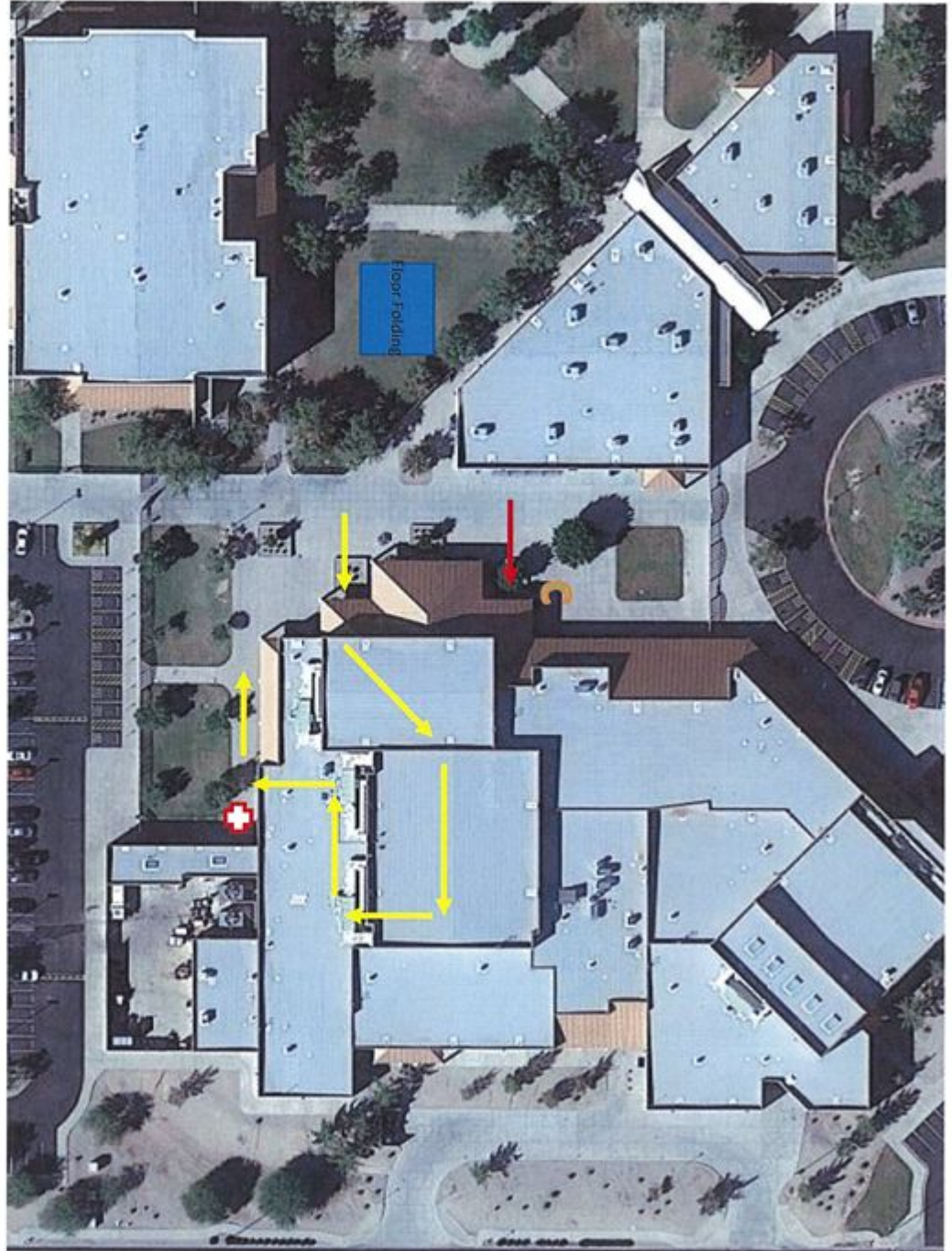
