

Mountain Ridge HS Contest Information Saturday, March 19, 2022

LOCATION

Mountain Ridge HS 22800 N 67th Ave Glendale, AZ 85310

FAN PARKING

Spectator/Guard Staff Parking

From 67th Avenue, turn west onto MRHS Driveway. Continue past the first parking lot on the right and proceed into the student parking area. Do not park in handicap spots or in drop-off lanes designated with a blue line. Once this parking lot is full, use the overflow lots reserved for spectators and staff.

Overflow Spectator Parking

We have two overflow parking areas, at churches just north of our campus. Both Mountain Ridge Baptist Church, located at 23104 N. 67th Avenue, and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, located at 23121 N. 67th Avenue, have approximately 150 spots available. Plan a 5 minute walk to the gymnasium.

Disabled Parking

From 67th Avenue, turn west into MRHS Driveway. Continue past the first parking lot on the right (for MRHS staff only), and proceed into the student parking area to the designated disabled spots closest to the gymnasium.

BUS/TRAILER PARKING

Performer Bus Instructions:

From 67th Avenue, turn WEST into the MOUNTAIN RIDGE DRIVEWAY entrance. Merge into the left lane, continue past the parking lot, and turn right into the bus lane (driveway before baseball fields). Stop at the check-in area. After check-in, volunteers will direct bus drivers to continue heading north in the bus lane, turn left (west) onto Patrick Lane, then turn left (south) onto 71st Avenue to park. Follow instructions on the signs, and directions of our parking volunteers. Bus Driver contact information should be provided to your chaperones so they can be contacted when your guard is ready to be picked-up.



Bus Parking:

Hillcrest Middle School, 22833 N. 71st Avenue, Glendale, 85310
Bus parking is along the bus parking lot and lanes of Hillcrest Middle School. An additional 12 spots are available in the parking lot directly in front of Hillcrest Middle School. If your guard is not staying until the completion of the invitational, please park buses on 71st Ave. PLEASE ADVISE PARKING VOLUNTEERS IF YOUR STUDENTS AND BUSES ARE STAYING FOR AWARDS

Equipment Truck Unloading and Parking:

From 67th Avenue, turn west on Patrick Lane and then turn left into the school Faculty Parking Lot (first entrance to left). THERE IS NO PARKING IN THIS PARKING LOT. After unloading your equipment, exit the parking area by turning left (west) back onto Patrick Lane and turn left (south) at 71st Avenue. Just past Hillcrest Middle School, you will turn left into the bus lane that will lead you into the parking lot location on the south side of Hillcrest Middle School.

Special Note for Semi-Trailers:

If you use a semi-trailer to travel, please contact Parking Lot Chairperson, Jodi Hamill at 602-549-9125 by for further entry and parking instructions by noon on Friday March 18, 2022.

CHECK IN & VIDEO

Students will disembark at the designated check-in area next to the equipment truck unloading area. Upon arrival, each Director will receive a packet containing wristbands for staff and volunteers and a meal ticket for your bus driver. Each unit will receive 7 staff wristbands in their packet. There is no video recording or flash photography allowed.

DIRECTORS/STAFF HOSPITALITY SUITE

A hospitality area for directors/staff is located inside the teacher's cafeteria at Mountain Ridge. We are providing meals and refreshments.

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CONCESSIONS

Concessions on-site will host snacks, drinks and full meal options including a gluten free option. Prices will vary from \$1 with no option higher than \$10 for combo pricing. Menu will be uploaded to directors' packet when finalized. PLEASE NOTE: No Food or Beverage other than water is allowed inside the gym performance area. We will have outdoor seating areas available for concessions.

No food is allowed in the Gym.

CHANGING AREA:

Restrooms are available for performers to change near the cafeteria, as designated on the Campus Map. Performers are NOT to change in the restrooms in the Gym as this area is reserved for spectator use.

Mountain Ridge HS 22800 N 67th Ave Glendale, AZ 85310

DIMENSIONS: 110' X 60'

FRONT SIDE BLEACHER ROWS: 12 SEATING CAPACITY: appx 1200

APPROXIMATE CEILING HEIGHT: appx 40 ft

There are no stairs to contend with in the competition area.

There are retractable hoops above the competition floor.

Units do not enter the competition area directly from outside.

There is electrical power available at the front and back sidelines.

Units do not exit the competition area directly to the outdoors.

There is no indoor prop storage available before your performance.

There is a designated fold the floors area outside the exit after the performance.

There will be a black, appx 60'X90', vinyl tarp with covering the performance gym floor.

The distance from the outdoor warm up area to the competition area is less than 5 minute.

The distance from the indoor warm up area to the competition area is less than 5 minute.

There are not separate areas for body and equipment.













