Bus/Equipment Truck Parking

All buses and trucks must enter at the SOUTH parking lot which is on Rose Garden Lane; there will be attendants and signs to designate where the buses and trucks go. Buses will be met by Festival Hosts who will take care of parking. Because space is at a premium, please have your staff ride the buses with you or park in spectator parking off of 27th Ave.

Check-In

There will be a check-in table when you pull into the South parking lot. At the check-in area, unit directors will be given wristbands for all performers. You will also receive a director's packet with show information and 7 additional wristbands for your staff/volunteers. If you are in need of more wristbands, we will have them for sale at the check-in table with **cash only.** If you would like to use a credit/debit card to purchase extra wristbands, you may do so at the spectator entrance to the gym.

Restrooms

There are restroom facilities located throughout the campus (see map). If facilities are needed to change clothes, please use these. There are also restrooms in the gym lobby that will be reserved for spectators. Locker rooms will not be available.



Spectator Parking/Entrance

Spectators may use the parking lot on 27th Ave, just north of Rose Garden Lane. Spectators will enter on the north side of the gymnasium, near the vendors and concessions.

Warm-up

Guard and percussion units will be allowed to warm-up in the approved areas (see map) starting at any time before your performance. Please be respectful of other groups when choosing a warm-up spot/time. Per WGAZ policy, units may not open floors on the outdoor courts or parking lots unless it is on top of a practice floor. If using a practice floor, again, please be courteous of space for other units.

Guards Only: Be aware of the time you are to report to the warm-up gym.

Timing Line

The timing line for this show is HORIZONTAL. Units will enter the main gym from the southeast corner and exit on the southwest door of the gym.

Floor Folding/Equipment Loading

Following the performance, units will carry their floor/equipment props/etc. to the football field for folding. You may then head back to the SOUTH parking lot to load equipment trucks before returning to the gymnasium. All floors/props/equipment must be loaded at this time.

Concession & Souvenirs

Please let your students and parents know that there will be a full concession stand available for their lunch and/or dinner needs. We have included a menu in this packet for your convenience. Shirts and other apparel as well as other music related souvenirs will be available for purchase at the show.

NO outside food or drinks will be allowed in the stadium area.



Unit Director Hospitality

We would like to invite all unit directors and their staff to enjoy our Hospitality room. Water, soft drinks, food and snacks will be available. All directors and staff must have an approved WGAZ badge or one of the 7 show provided wristbands for staff.

Award Ceremony

There will be one awards ceremony at the end of the show for both guard and percussion with captains only. Immediately following the last performance, guard and percussion captains will need to report to the Warm-up Gym for the retreat line-up.

Critique

The critique will be held in the Judge's Hospitality room following the conclusion of your portion of the show. Please make sure your information is up to date in competition suite to get updates regarding critique.


